PREPARATION:

SURFACE PREPARATION:

Promarker is designed as a short-life spot marker and as such is likely to be used on all kinds of surfaces. If applied in damp conditions, the markings will be very short-lived.

APPLICATION:

Apply manually by hand or by using Meon aerosol application equipment.

Before use: Shake the can vigorously upside down for approximately 2 minutes, to mix the paint thoroughly.

Spray, holding upside down, and apply at approx. 10cm from background for precise marking

CURING:

DRYING TIME:

Usually a maximum of 5-10 mins, depending on temperature

TECHNICAL:

PRACTICAL COVERAGE:

500ml can: typically 2.2m² 750ml can: typically 3.3m²

AFTERCARE AND MAINTENANCE:

Use **Meon Type 2 thinners** or **Aerosol thinners** to clean uncured Promarker from tools and equipment.

STORAGE AND PACKAGING:

STORAGE CONDITIONS:

Storage area should be dry, protected from direct sunlight and extremes of temperature - i.e. between 5°C and 20°C.

SHELF LIFE:

Minimum 12 months when stored under cover, in original unopened containers, in accordance with Storage Condition guidelines listed above.

SIZES AVAILABLE:

Available in 500ml and 750ml cans.
