UltraNuvo is a clear primer designed for priming asphalt surfaces before application of MMA and PU-based anti-skid and slip-resistant coatings. It has a very short cure time, reaching full strength by the end of the cure time. This enables it to be used as a primer for new laid surfaces as any bitumen "bleed" is caught within the primer and prevented from migrating to the finishing treatment.

PREPARATION:

SURFACE PREPARATION:

The application surface should be sound and clean, free from grease, oil, rust, scale, dirt, or any other soiling that might affect adhesion or performance.

Whilst we cannot guarantee results on un-oxidised asphalt or tarmacadam, extensive tests have shown a high success rate on such surfaces.

MIXING:

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

After thoroughly mixing the base resin, add catalyst and slowly mix until there are no more lumps.

STIRRING TIME:

At least 2 min.

APPLICATION:

Pour mixed contents onto roller tray and apply to surface with medium pile roller (supplied in UltraNuvo kits).

CURING:

CURING TIME:

Rainproof after: approx. 25 min. @ 20°C Can be walked on/recoated: approx. 45 min. @ 20°C Pot Life: approx. 10 min. @ 20°C

COVERAGE:

Typically 1.8 - 2m² per kg

AFTERCARE AND MAINTENANCE:

Use UltraClean X795 to clean any uncured UltraNuvo primer from tools and equipment.

STORAGE AND PACKAGING:

STORAGE CONDITIONS:

Storage area should be dry, protected from direct sunlight and extremes of temperature - i.e. between 5°C and 20°C.

SHELF LIFE:

12 months when stored under cover, in original unopened containers, in accordance with Storage Condition guidelines listed above.
