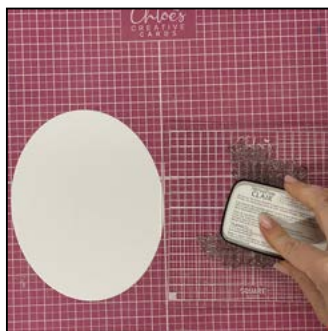
General crafting tools including a heat tool, guillotine, and scissors



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1 Matt and layer the card front as shown, glittering the edges of some layers and adhering some using 3D foam pads. Die-cut an oval from white cardstock.



2 Stamp the flower spray across the top and bottom of the oval using the Morning Mist ink.



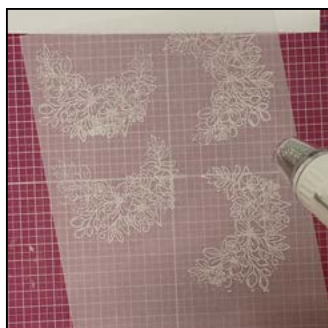
3 Infill the leaves with Grasshopper glitter, add dots of Crystal Pink glitter to the smaller flower sprays.



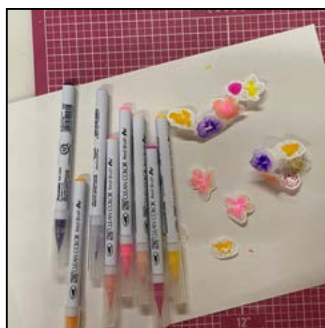
4 Stamp another two flower sprays onto white cardstock using the Morning Mist ink and cut out some of the leaves and flowers.



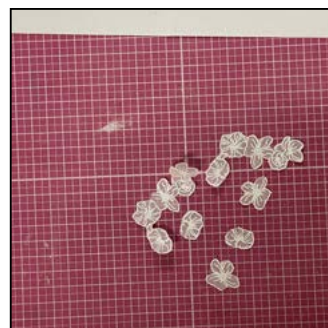
5 Infill the leaves with Grasshopper glitter.



6 Stamp four flower sprays onto vellum using clear ink, cover with white embossing powder and heat to set.



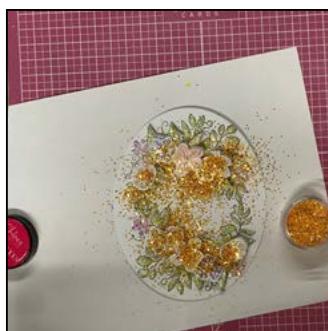
7 Turn over the vellum, to work on the back and add colour to the flowers.



8 Cut two flower sprays that are just the flowers and cut a couple of flowers from the second image.



9 Layer the vellum flowers onto the glittered oval, attaching using 3D glue gel.



10 Add dots of Fiesta glitter onto the centres of the flowers.



11 Stamp the sentiment onto white cardstock, trim to size and affix in the centre of the oval. Die-cut four daisies and cover with Crystallina glitter, then attach using 3D glue gel, then onto the card front. Finish with strips of green paper, as the daisy stems.
