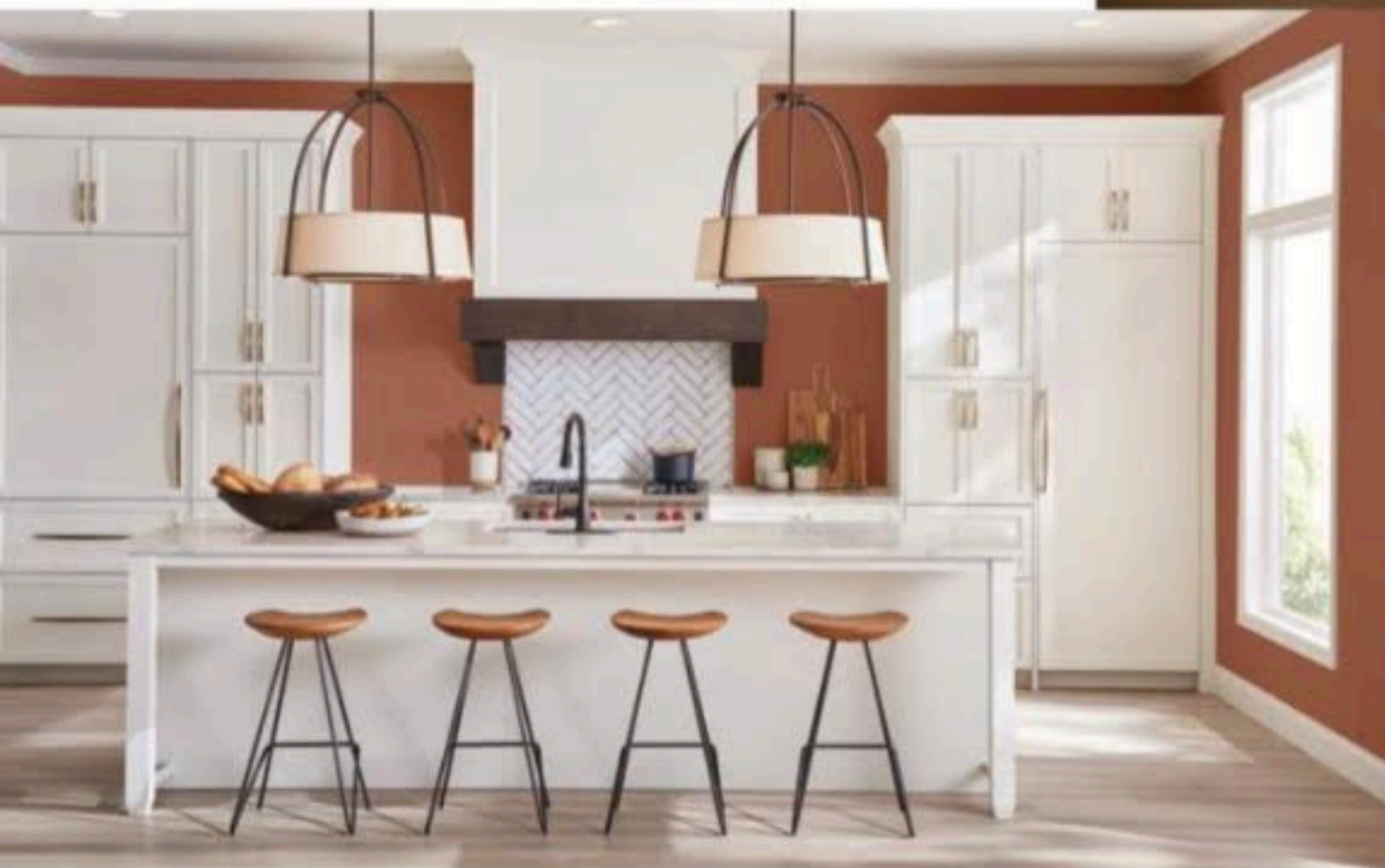
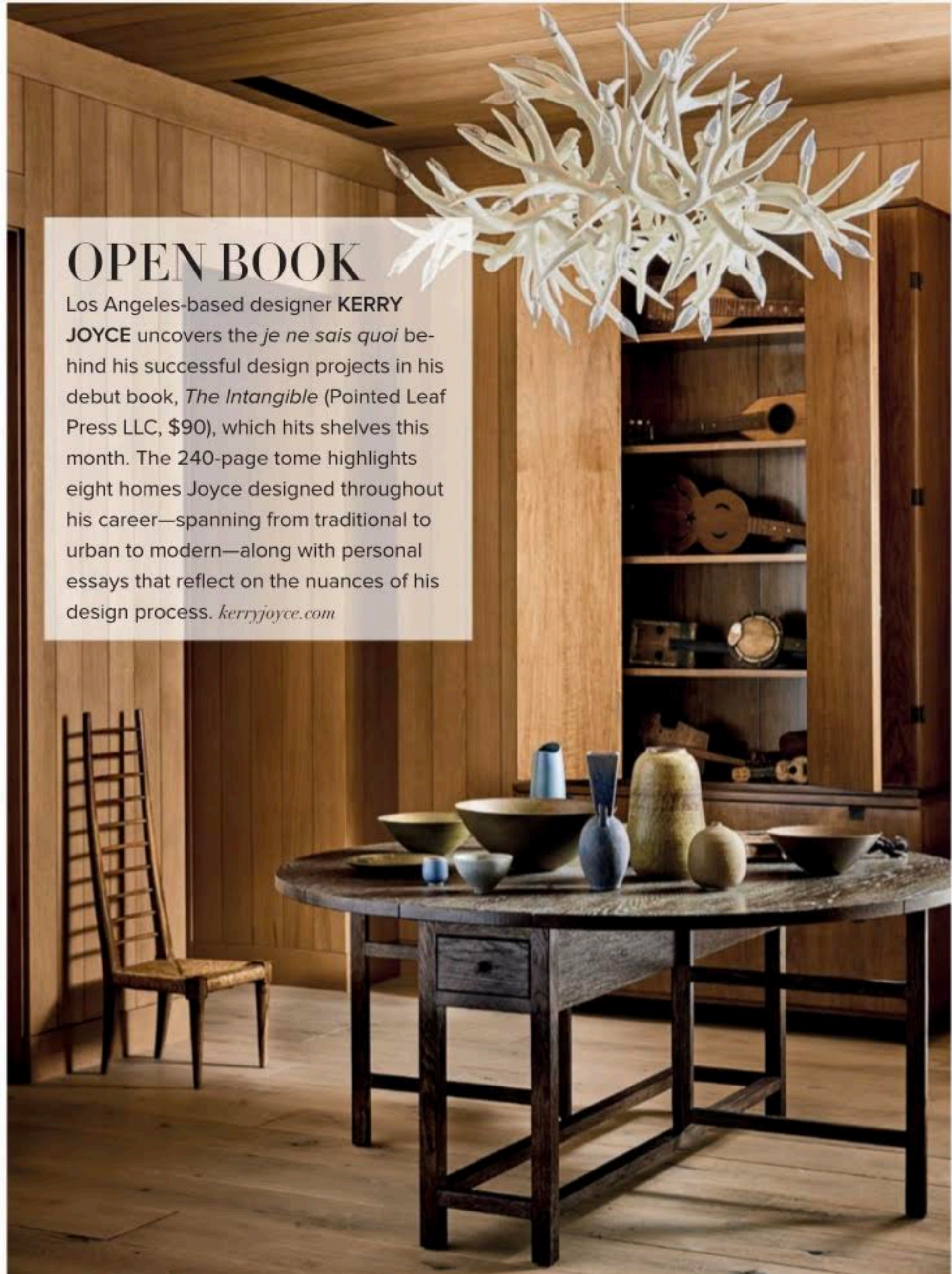


Penley Panache
