



## Caring for your Powder Coating!

Powder coating is an extremely durable surface coating. To ensure you get the longest life out of your powder coating regular care & maintenance is recommended. Harsh liquids, powders, and cleaners should be strongly avoided! Using these will damage the powder coating.

### Clean your Powder Coating in 4 Easy Steps

1. Start by wiping the surface gently with a wet sponge to remove any loose debris.
2. Remove dust, coffee grinds and other deposits by using a soft cloth, sponge or a soft natural bristle brush (non-abrasive) with a solution of warm water and mild detergent ONLY. One way to tell if the soap is mild enough is determining if the product is safe for your hands. If you have to wear gloves to protect your hands, it's not safe for the powder coat either!
3. Thoroughly rinse the surfaces afterward with fresh water to remove all residues.
4. Allow to dry naturally or use a clean, dry cloth to achieve a cleaner look.

### **WARNING**

- Do NOT use a wire or rough brush to clean the powder coating.
- Do NOT under any circumstances use strong or aggressive solvents such as thinners, turpentine, white spirits, citrus-based cleaners or solutions containing chlorinated hydrocarbons, esters or ketones. Abrasive cleaners or cutting compounds should not be used.
- Do NOT rub powder-coated surfaces excessively, especially metallic finishes.

Failure to adhere to this maintenance guide will cause damage to your powder coating and therefore the look of your coffee equipment. Coffee Machine Emporium will not cover damage caused by incorrect cleaning.
