## \#268 Hearts Bag

## You Will Need

- Felt
- A few metres of ribbon
- A wool needle
- Sharp scissors
- A seam ripper (optional)


## DIFFICULTY •••

Painted sticks can be used to brighten up a mantelpiece, can be placed in a vase instead of flowers, hung as a mobile, or just painted for the fun of it.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Cut out heart shapes from felt pieces, and using the pointed end of a seam ripper make an even number of vertical slits across the heart $-4,6$ or 8 . Keeping the slits even allows the ribbon to enter and leave the heart on the front (or back).
Step 2: Thread the wool needle with the ribbon and weave it in and out of

## You Will Need

- $1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ ball of Double Knitting Yarn (Multicolour) by Lincraft
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- $1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball Fairy Floss yarn (Pink) by Lincraft


## FRONT/BACK OF BAG (Make 2)

With Multicolour yarn make 57ch.
1st row: Miss 3ch, 1tr into next ch to end (3ch count as 1tr, 55tr). Turn work at the end of each row.

Rows 2 \&15\&28: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr into next 53tr, tr in top ch at end of row.
Rows 3\&16: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr into next 14tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 23tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr into next $14 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{tr}$ in top ch at end of row.

Rows 4\&17: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr into next 12tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 19tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next 12 tr , tr in top ch at end of row

Rows 5\&18: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr into next 10tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 3tr, 1tr in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next 15tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next tr, 1 tr in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in next 3 tr , 1 tr in ch sp, 1 tr in next tr, 1ch, miss $1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in next $10 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in top ch at end of row.

Rows 6\&19: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr in next 8tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 7tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 11tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 7tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 8tr, tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 7\&20: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr in next 6tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 11tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr into 7tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next $11 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in ch sp, 1tr in next tr,1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 6tr, tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 8\&21: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr into next 4tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 15tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 3tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 15tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 4tr, tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 9\&22: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr in next 2tr, *(1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next tr, 1 tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 19tr, 1 tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr) repeat from * 1 more time, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next 2 tr , tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 10\&23: 1dc, 2ch, 1 tr in next 2tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 23tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 23tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 2 tr , tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 11\&24: 1dc, 2ch, 1 tr in next 2tr, *(1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next 11tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next 11 tr ) repeat_rom * 1 more time, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next 2 tr , tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 12\&25: 1dc, 2dc, 1tr in next 2tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, *(1tr in next 7tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr) repeat from * 2 more times, 1tr in next 7tr, 1ch, miss_ tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 2tr, tr in top ch at end of row.

Rows 13\&26: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr in next 4tr, 1tr in ch sp, *(1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 3tr, 1tr in ch sp) repeat from * 2 more times, 1 tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1 tr in next tr, 1ch, miss 1 tr , 1 tr in next tr,

1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 4tr, tr in top ch at end of row.
Rows 14\&27: 1dc, 2ch, 1tr in next 6tr, *(1tr in ch sp, 1 tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1 tr in next tr, 1 tr in ch sp, 1tr in next 7tr) repeat from * 2 more times, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in ch sp, 1tr in next $\mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in $\mathrm{ch} \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in next $6 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{tr}$ in top ch at end of row.

## STRAP

Using Multicolour yarn. Make ch 110cm long or desired length. Miss 2ch, dc in each ch to end. Rows 2-5: dc to end.

## ASSEMBLING THE BAG

To join bag, dc evenly along side, bottom edge and other side using Multicolour yarn. Sew ends to each side of bag.

## HEART TRIM

Using 2 strands of Fairy Floss yarn, weave into ch sp design.
Finish off all loose ends.
the slits in the hearts, gently pulling each heart along so they are evenly spaced.
Hang the garland and enjoy!
