Double 8 Ply Beanie

You Will Need:

1 x 100g ball of Double Knitting, Cosy Wool or Superwash yarn by Lincraft
7mm knitting needles
Yarn needle

NOTE: This Beanie is knitted using two strands of yarn together.

TENSION: 13 stitches x 19 rows to 10cm using 7mm needles.

SIZES:	2-4 years	6-8 years	Adult
	51-52cm	53-55cm	56cm

Begin Beanie

Using 7mm needles and yarn double, cast on 57 (59-61) sts.

1st row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows for 8 cm, ending with a 2nd row.

Work in stocking st until Beanie measures 16 (17-19) cm from cast on, ending with a knit row.

Next row: Purl and decrease (0-2-4) sts evenly across ... 57 sts.

Shape crown

1st row: K1, * K2tog, K5, rep from * to end ... 49 sts.

2nd and alternate rows: Purl.

3rd row: K1, * K2tog, K4, rep from * to end ... 41 sts.

5th row: K1, * K2tog, K3, rep from * to end ... 33 sts.

7th row: K1, * K2tog, K2, rep from * to end ... 25 sts.

9th row: K1, * K2tog, K1, rep from * to end ... 17 sts.

11th row: K1, * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 9 sts.

Cut yarn and thread through rem stitches. Draw up and fasten securely.
Sew seam, reversing for lower 4cm for brim. Turn up brim.
