Garden Dangle Bracelet

Instructions

Measure your wrist and cut the chain to length required. Attach each part of the toggle clasp onto each end of the chain with a jump ring. To work out how to arrange the charms and beads work from the middle, choose a bead or charm to go in the centre and then both sides will have the same pattern of beads/charms (each side will mirror the other) On a flat surface lay your beads and charms out to work out the order you wish them to go. Attach a jump ring to each charm. Insert a head pin into the beads, trim approx 8mm from the bead and form a loop with the round nose pliers. If the charms are one sided make sure they are all facing the same way. Find the centre of your chain and insert the middle charm/bead into the middle link of the chain. Pattern of pictured bracelet on one side from the middle link to the end of the chain is:- Flower charm, green and pink 4mm on one head pin, swirl charm, pink teardrop, swirl charm, green round bead, green and pink 4mm, flower charm, pink bicone, swirl charm, green oblong, swirl charm and green and pink 4mm bead. Repeat on the other side.
