Wooden beads

YOU WILL NEED

- ❑ Natural Wooden Beads - 20mm x 7
- ❑ Reeves acrylic paint
- white, lime yellow
- ❑ Brush
- ❑ Sullivans Fine Glitter
- we used pastel opal
- ❑ Mod podge
- ❑ JF twine thread - 65cm

DIFFICULTY ●●●

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1:

Paint all beads with white paint. Using a paint brush to hold bead and twist to facilitate painting.

Step 2:

Paint 3 beads with lime yellow paint. Two or three coats will ensure an even colour.

Step 3:

Paint one lime yellow bead with mod podge and sprinkle with glitter. Once dry cover glitter bead with another layer of mod podge. Allow to dry.

Step 4:

Feed jewellery twine through all beads and ties ends together with a double knot.
