Rectangular
Lace Shawl

MEASUREMENTS

Depth (approx)	cm	60
Length (approx)	cm	170

Yarn Required:

Lincraft Cakes	200g balls	2
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DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES:

A pair of 7.00mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

16 sts and 18 rows to 10cm over patt, using 7.00mm needles.

This Shawl has been designed to be worked on larger needles and at a looser tension than usually recommended.

SHAWL (worked sideways)

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on 94 sts.

1st row: K3, * yfwd, K2, sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: K2, * yfwd, K2, sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

4th row: Purl.

Last 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until Shawl measures approx 170cm from beg, ending with a 4th patt row.
Cast off loosely knitways.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends.
