Elephant Heat Pack #A531

DIFFICULTY ● ● ●

Approximate Time of project: 30 minutes

MATERIALS

20cm of flannelette (or any sturdy cotton fabric)
Uncooked Rice
Elephant heat pack pattern
Thread

EQUIPMENT

Scissors
Sewing machine
Pins
Tailors chalk

STEPS

1. Cut out paper pattern.
2. Place fabric with right side together.
3. Place pattern onto the fabric, draw a 1cm seam allowance around the edge of the pattern.
4. Cut fabric out along the drawn line.
5. With right sides together, sew the ear together.
6. Clip the curves and flip inside out.
7. On one right side of the elephant shape, place the ear the wrong way around. Sew along line.
8. Fold ear back to correct position, sew into place.
9. With right sides together sew around the elephant shape and leaving a small gap. Clip all the seams
10. Flip the elephant inside out.
11. Fill the heat pack with rice
12. Close gap in heat pack with an invisible stitch.
