Approximate Time of project: 2+ hours (plus drying time)

MATERIALS

Blue sequins
 Crafty Bitz jewels
 White felt
 Sliver and blue ribbon
 50cm Cobalt party lurex
 50cm Turquoise party satin
 60cm Organza
 White yarn
 3D Puff paint
 Headband
 White shirt
 Elastic
 Fabric glue
 Fray stop

NOTE: Materials listed will create a costume to fit a 6-year-old. Please increase/decrease materials if making a costume of a different size.

EQUIPMENT

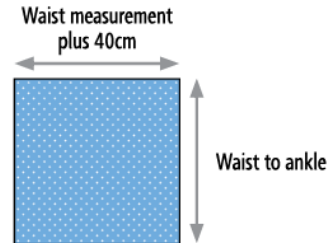
Sewing machine
 Pins
 Scissors
 Hot glue gun
 Tailor's chalk
 Snowflake template

STEPS

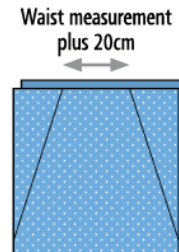
SKIRT

1. Measure and note the following measurements:
 - a. Waist
 - b. Waist to ankle

2. Cut out two rectangles of fabric that is the waist measurement plus 40cm and waist to ankle.



3. Draw two lines from the bottom corners to create an A-line shape. The top measurement should be approximately the waist measurement plus 20cm.

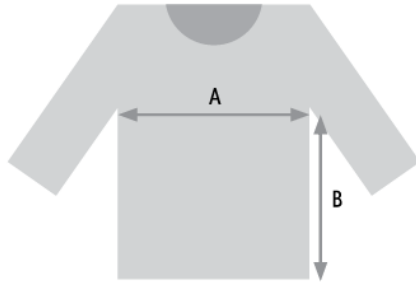


4. Cut out two panels.
5. Place skirt panels right sides together. Pin and stitch down the sides.
6. Turn down 3cm on the top edge skirt to the wrong side of the fabric to create a casing for elastic. Pin into place and stitch leaving a small gap.
7. Thread elastic through the casing. Pin the ends of elastic together, and stitch together

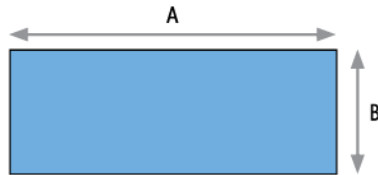


TOP

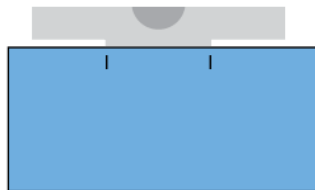
1. Lay the shirt flat. Measure and note the following measurements:
 - a. Chest area, double it and add 5cm
 - b. Underarm to bottom edge.



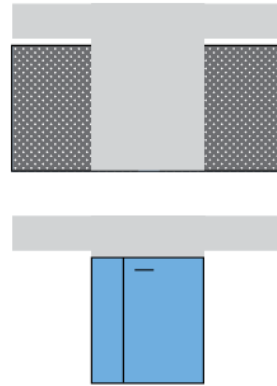
2. Cut out a rectangle in the blue Lurex using the measurements.



3. Lay the lurex over the shirt with right sides facing up. Pin the lurex to the shirt at the underarms.

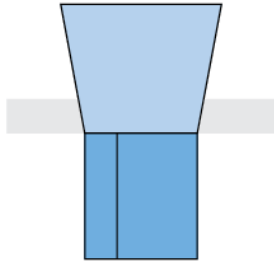


4. Flip shirt around and wrap strip ends over each other. Pin into place.



5. Slide a piece of scrap cardboard or paper into the shirt to stop the glue going to the other side of the shirt.
6. Glue the lurex to the front of the shirt with the fabric glue.
7. Decorate the collar with jewels and sequins.
8. Cut a 60cm by 100cm rectangle of organza fabric. Use fray stop to reduce the fabric fraying.
9. Place the snowflake templates under the organza and trace the snowflakes. Trace the snowflake shapes using 3D puff paint. Allow to fully dry before moving to next step.
10. Gather the top of the cape to be the same width as the back of the shirt. Pin and stitch to secure gather.
11. Slide the cape under the lurex fabric and pin into place.





12. Zig zag stitch the cape and the blue lurex to the shirt.

HEADBAND

1. Wrap the headband in ribbon and secure with the hot glue.
2. Cut a strip of the stiffen felt that is 6cm wide. Secure onto the headband with the hot glue gun.
3. Cut numerous lengths of yarn and ribbons that is double the headband length.
4. Fold the lengths of yarn and ribbons in half and twist.
5. Using the hot glue gun, glue twisted yarn to the headband.
6. Cut numerous 1.4m lengths of yarn for the ponytail.
7. Fold the lengths of yarn in half and using the hot glue gun, glue the folded end to the headband. Wrap silver ribbon around the ends of the headband to hide the yarn ends.
8. Split the ponytail yarn into three sections and braid.
9. Secure end of braid with extra yarn and a ribbon bow. Trim ponytail to neaten
