Square Knot

DIFFICULTY ●●●

Approximate Time of Project: 1 hour

MATERIALS

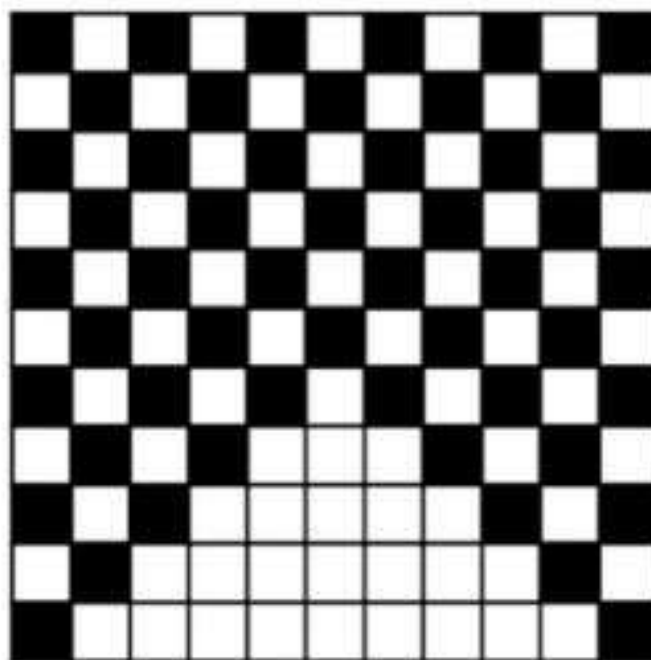
Dowel (and string to tie it up)
Macrame cord

EQUIPMENT

Ruler
Scissors

STEPS

1. Cut 13 lengths of cord to 2m each.
2. Fold 12 lengths in half and knot along dowel. Set one length aside.
3. Create 6 square knots at the top. Follow the pattern template to create the shape.
4. Bring the two end strings, from each side, together.
5. Form a Square knot using these 4 strings. This will bring the shape into a circle.
6. Using the leftover length, from step 2, tie a knot around all the cords 15cm beneath the last square knot.
7. Wind the length tightly around the rest of the cords for 5cm and secure.
8. Cut all hanging cords to the same length.
9. Hang your wall hanging from a secure place on your wall. Place a pot plant in the basket formed (steps 5-8).
