Approximate Time of Project: 30min (drying time not included)

MATERIALS

Coloured card stock Floristry wire (or a skewer) Hot glue

EQUIPMENT

Pencil Scissors Hot glue gun Pliers Wire cutters

HELPFUL HINTS

- If using a skewer rather than floristry wire glue the base
 of the flower to the top of the skewer. You may find you
 need to reinforce it with additional hot glue at the join.
- Print the templates at "Actual Size" on your printer to ensure the flowers are the right size.

STEPS

- 1. Chrysanthemums and Tulips:
 - a. Cut a Stamen shape from the yellow cardstock.
 - **b.** Roll the cardstock tightly on itself and glue to create a tight spiral.
 - c. Ruffle up the shredded side of the Stamen.
 - d. Cut one flower shape from two different tones of cardstock.
 - Roll each petal over a pen so they curve in on the flower
 - **f.** Glue the two flower shapes together in the middle.
 - **g.** Glue the Stamen to the middle of the flower so the ruffled part sticks up.
 - h. Twist the floristry wire into a loose spiral and twist on its side.
 - Glue the wire spiral to the base of the Chrysanthemum or Tulip.

2. Leaves:

- a. Cut the Leaf shape out on green cardstock.
- **b.** Fold it in half around the floristry wire stem.
- **c.** Glue the halves together to the stem.

3. Allow your flowers and leaves to dry completely before decorating your dessert.
