**Beaded Wreath**

INTERMEDIATE

**DIFFICULTY** ●●●

Approximate Time of Project: 20 minutes

**MATERIALS**

Metal ring  
Large wooden beads  
Faux flowers and leaves  
Bead glue  
Stiff felt

**EQUIPMENT**

Wire cutters  
Scissors

**STEPS**

1. Cut the metal ring at or near the join.
2. Thread the beads onto the ring by pushing one end back and one end forward rather than apart which can risk bending the ring. Add beads until the ring is filled  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way.
3. The ring should spring back together when not held apart. Apply glue to the ends of the wire and hold a bead over it to hide the join. Allow to dry.
4. Push all the beads together and glue the two beads at either end to the wire to prevent movement. Allow to dry.
5. Cut two 10x5cm ovals from the felt and glue together sandwiching the middle of the metal ring between them. Allow to dry.
6. Glue the leaves to the ovals fanning out from the centre around the ring. Allow to dry.
7. Cut the flowers off their stems 1cm from the top.
8. Glue the flowers on top of the leaves and allow to dry.
9. Hang wreath to display.
