



#### **DIFFICULTY** •••

Approximate Time of Project: 30 minutes

#### **MATERIALS**

Sweety Twills fabric (90x160 per cushion)
Cord piping
25mm bias binding (4m for circle, 5m for square)
Thread
Soft fill

### **EQUIPMENT**

Scissors
Iron
Ironing board
Pins
Zipper foot
Sewing machine
Sewing needle

# **CUT LIST** (5mm seam allowance included)

Circle Cushion:

Two 61cm circles (TOP & BOTTOM)
Two 95x13cm rectangles SIDE
Square Cushion:
Two 61x61cm squares (TOP & BOTTO

Two 61x61cm squares (TOP & BOTTOM)
Two 121x13cm rectangles SIDE





## **STEPS**

- 1. Make the piping;
  - a. Iron the bias binding open and flat.
  - b. Place the cording in the centre of the bias binding on the wrong side.
  - c. Fold the binding over the cord and pin in place with the ends of the binding touching.
  - d. Baste the cord in place close to the binding by hand.
- 2. Pin the binding around the TOP piece on the right side with the raw edges touching.
- 3. Use the straight stitch presser foot to baste the piping to the TOP piece. Overlap the ends on the side to taper them into the seam and hide them.
- 4. Repeat the above for the BOTTOM piece.
- 5. Sew the two rectangles together to create one 190x13cm (for the circle) or 241x13cm (for the square) strip.
- 6. Pin the SIDE around the edge of the circle TOP piece right sides together.
- 7. Use the zipper foot to sew as close to the piping as possible.
- When you reach the end of the strip pin the 13cm ends together and sew.
- Repeat from 2e with the remaining raw edge of the SIDE strip and the BOTTOM piece. Leave a 10cm gap around this edge.
- 10.Clip the curved edges or corners and turn the cushion right side out.
- 11. Stuff the cushion through the 10cm gap left.
- 12.Use a mattress stitch to sew up the gap so it is not visible.
