



DIFFICULTY •••

Approximate Time of Project: 240 minutes

MATERIALS

2 meters Printed Polar Fleece 2 meters Plain Polar Fleece

EQUIPMENT

Fabric Scissors Sullivans Quilters Ruler 16.25x16.25cm

HELPFUL HINTS

When pulled gently along the grain, the Polar Fleece will curl towards the wrong side.

STEPS

- 1. Line Printed Polar Fleece and Plain Polar Fleece together with the right side facing the outside. See
- 2. Trim selvage. Pin the 2 Polar Fleece together to help it stay in place.
- 3. Use Sullivans Quilters Ruler to cut 6 inch squares out of the corners.
- 4. Cut 1-inch strips, 1 inch wide along the 4 sides. Use a marker to rule this out and then cut.
- 5. Tie the two pieces of Polar Fleece together in a knot by looping it through and pushing it upwards.
- 6. Finish tying all the knots on all 4 sides of the blanket.
- 7. Remove pins used to hold the Polar Fleece in place.
