Ironing Board Cover

how to make

Ironing Board Cover

DIFFICULTY

Easy - approx. 1 hour

MATERIALS

- · Grey Geometric Flower Fabric
- Cotton Wadding
- Sullivans Elastic 12mm
- Matching Thread

EQUIPMENTS

- Sewing Machine
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Safety Pins
- Pins
- Scissors

STEPS

- Lay ironing board on top of the cotton wadding and trace around it. Cut it out.
- 2. Lay ironing board on top of the fabric and trace around it. Use a ruler to measure 8cm extra around the template and cut.
- 3. Fold and iron the raw edges of the fabric. Fold and iron a channel on the fabric with enough space to feed the elastic through. Pin it in place. Sew the channel and leave a 10cm opening for the elastic.
- 4. Pin the safety pin to one end of the elastic and feed through the channel. Fit the wadding onto the ironing board. Stretch the ironing board cover over the ironing board to see how much elastic you need. Tie off the elastic and cut the excess elastic off.
