Seashell Crochet Blanket

Intermediate

DIFFICULTY

Intermediate - Approx. 5 hour

MATERIALS

- 2 metres printed polar fleece
- 2 metres plain polar fleece
- Makr Teddy Soft Yarn chambray blue x 2

EQUIPMENTS

- Fabric scissors
- Crochet hook
- Pins
- Rotary cutter skip blade
- Cutting edge rotary cutter
- Quilter ruler
- Cutting mat

STEPS

1. Line printed polar fleece and plain polar fleece together with right side facing outside.

See helpful hints.

2. Trim selvage. Pin both polar fleece together to help it stay in place.

3. Use ruler as a guide when cutting the fabric using the rotary skip blade tool. Place fabric flat onto cutting mat and push pressure down and roll forward with the rotary blade. You will see small holes that are large enough to push a crochet hook through.

4. Make a slip knot. Single crochet around the whole blanket.

5. Tie off. Remove pins used to hold the polar fleece in place.

Helpful Hints When pulled gently along the grain, the polar fleece will curl towards the wrong side.
