

Christmas napkin holders

YOU WILL NEED	
1 x ball of red cosy wool (scraps are fine for this project)	
1 x ball of white cosy wool (scraps are fine for this project)	
1 x large jingle bell for each napkin holder you are making.	
4mm knitting needles	

DIFFICULTY • • •

Suitable for complete beginners, this project uses not much yarn, and is worked in stocking stitch throughout. An ideal project for children.

Cast on 20 stitches in red yarn.

Work 5 rows in stocking stitch.

Change to white yarn and work 2 rows of stocking stitch.

Work a further 2 rows red, 2 rows white, 2 rows red, 2 rows white and finish with 5 rows of red. The finished piece will be red with 3 white stripes.

Cast off, and sew together, and sew on a jingle bell.
