Christmas Stocking

Easy

DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 20 minutes

MATERIALS

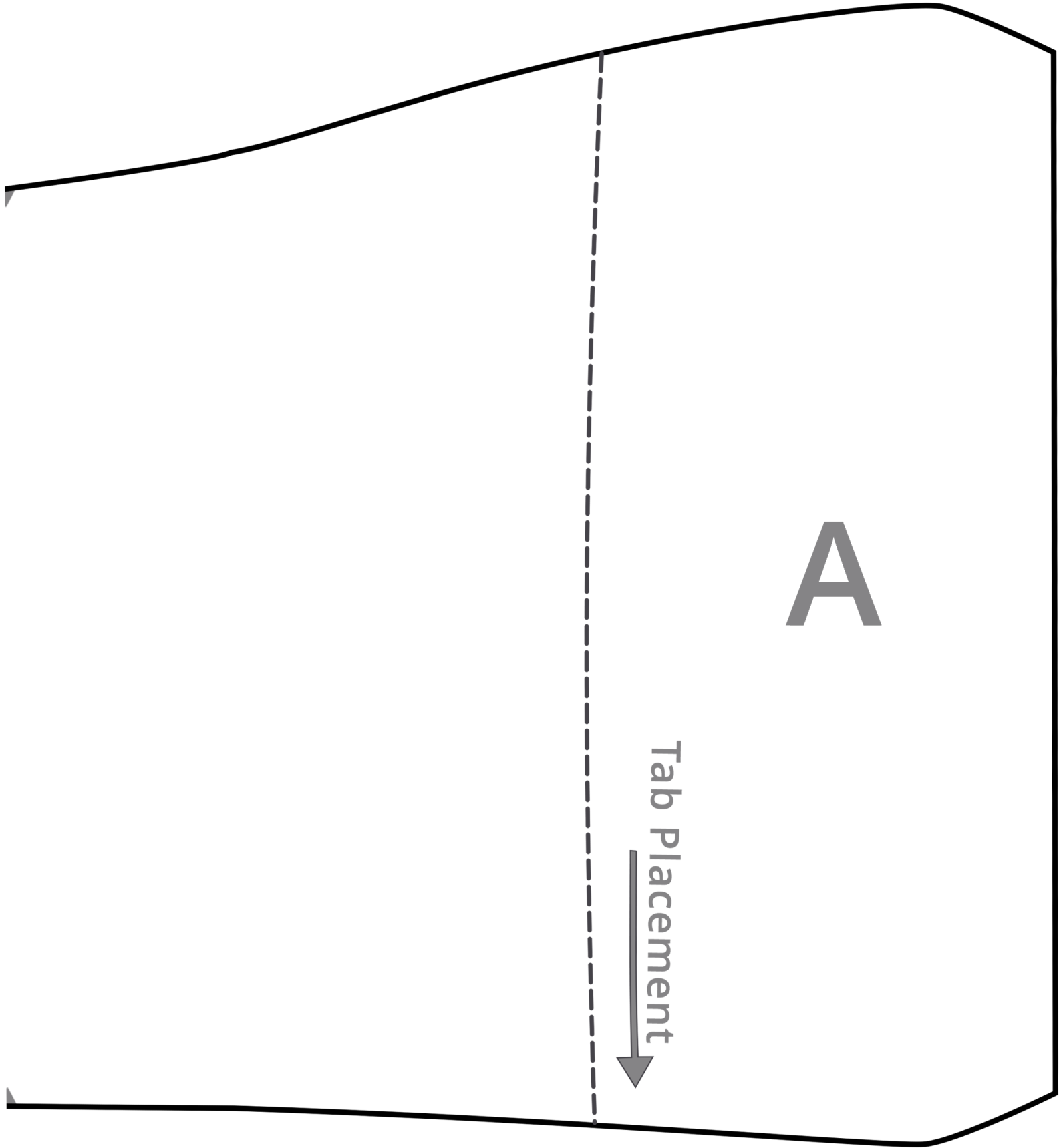
- Green/ gingerbread man fat quarter x2
- White fleece ½ meter
- Matching thread

EQUIPMENTS

- Template
- Sewing Machine
- Pinking Shears
- Pins
- Iron / Ironing board
- Safety pin

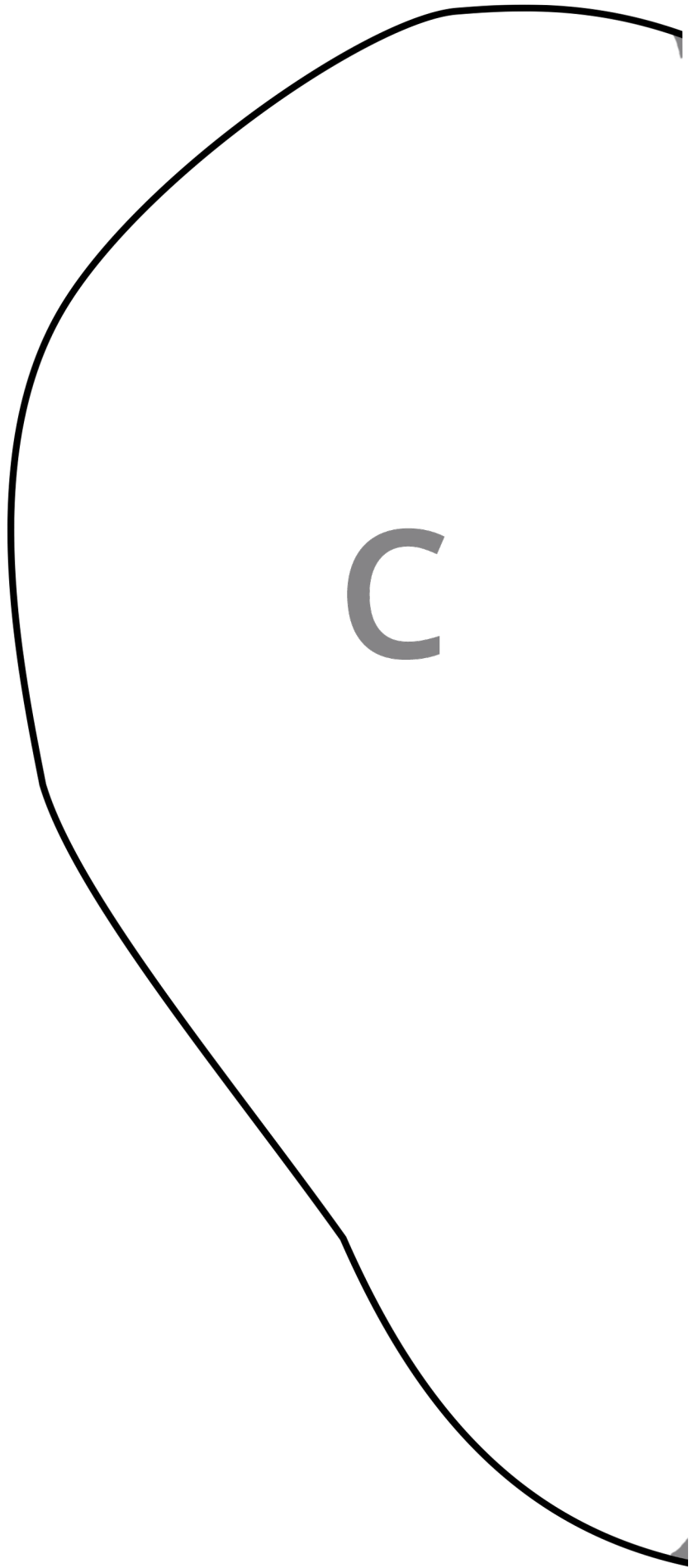
STEPS

1. Cut out pattern.
2. Fold the tap in half, pin together and sew. Turn it right side out using a safety pin.
3. Place 2 Christmas fabrics, right sides together. Pin in place and sew leaving the top open.
4. Place 2 fleece fabrics together. Place the tap in between the 2 pieces about 10cm down and pin. Pin stocking in place. Sew leaving the top open and a 10cm gap for turning.
5. Use pinking shears to cut around the stocking to remove any bulkiness.
6. Lay the stocking wrong sides out and the lining right sides out. Insert the lining into the stocking and match up the seams. Pin together and sew the top.
7. Turn the stocking right side out. Find the gap and sew it closed. Insert the lining back into the stocking. Fold the cuff over until you see the tap and iron flat.





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
