Craft Master's Apron

Intermediate



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DIFFICULTY

Intermediate - Approx. 3 hour

MATERIALS

- Deep Lake Cotton Fabric
- Craft Fabric
- Matching thread
- Sullivans iron on motif
- Simplicity iron on application

EQUIPMENTS

- Sewing Machine
- Fabric Scissors
- Pinking Shears
- Pins
- Iron / Ironing Board
- Ruler
- Pencil

8. With the apron right side out, fold and tuck the raw edge inside and lay the strap so it is not twisted and pin in place. Sew along the edge.

STEPS

1. Fold both fabrics in half and draw the following measurements and cut.

A - 87cm

B - 14cm

C - 38cm

D - 59cm

Curve from B to D.

2. Cut the following strips from the craft fabric. One is for the neck strap and the other 2 are for tying the apron together.

6cm x 65cm cut 3

Fold and press both edges of the straps. Fold in half and press. Sew along the edges.

3. Cut the following pockets using pinking shears.

A -16cm x 17cm x4

B-19cm x 23cm x2

C-11cm x 12cm x4

D-35cm x 35 cm x2

4. Fold and iron the raw edges of the pockets. Sew along the top of each pocket.

5. Iron on applications to pockets A.

6. Pin and sew all the pockets in place. Make sure to sew just 3 sides of the pockets and also down the middle of pocket B.

7. Pin right sides together leaving the top open. Pin the straps in place and tuck them inside. Sew around the edges. Pull the apron through the gap. Fold and sew the raw edge of the strap.











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
