



DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 30 minutes

plus drying time

MATERIALS

Makr Tie Dye Super Tub

Water

Pencil

100% Cotton Fabric or apparel (pre washed)


EQUIPMENTS

Sink

Cooling Tray

Handy hints

Pre wash all fabrics before tie dyeing to get the best dyeing absorption. After tie dyeing, wrap and allow to set for 6 to 8 hours. Rinse and dry.



STEPS

Swirl Tie Dye

Step 1

Pinch a small section in the center of the fabric and twist while you hold that section.

Step 2

Secure fabric with rubber bands crisscrossing them over the center.

Step 3

Apply a different colour of dye in each wedge created by the crisscrossing rubber bands.


Bullseye Tie Dye

Step 1

Pinch the fabric into a tube and add as many or as few rubber bands as you want.

Step 2

Apply desired dye colours to sections of the fabric.



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Heart Tie Dye

Step 1

Fold fabric in half. Draw half of a heart shape on the folded edge with a pencil.

Step 2

Starting at one end of the line, begin making small accordion pleats.

Step 3

Secure it with a rubber band. Add more rubber bands on the outside section.

Horizontal Stripes

Step 1

Fold the fabric in a series of accordion folds.

Step 2

Secure the folds with rubber bands placing a rubber band every 4cm.

Step 3

To create stripes, apply dye colours in alternating sections.
