

## DIFFICULTY

Intermediate - Approx. 2 Hour

## MATERIALS

- Sullivans metal ring 175 mm
- Makr Venture aquamarine yarn
- Sullivans tiger tuft feather x3
- Strung turq beads x2
- Embroidery floss
- Arbee wood beads 25 mm raw x3


## EQUIPMENTS

- Scissors
- Embroidery needle


STEPS

1. Tie a knot and wrap the ring with yarn. Continue all the way around until the ring is completely covered. Tie a knot to the original end and trim it off.
2. With embroidery floss tie a knot to the ring. Pull the embroidery floss a few centimeters across and wrap it around the ring and back through the opening pulling it tight. Continue all the way around until you get back to your starting point. Once you complete the first circle continue the same process of looping the embroidery floss over, under and through the midpoint of each section tightening the floss as you go. Work your way to the middle and tie it off with a knot.
3. Thread beads onto embroidery floss and tie it to a feather. Create 3 in total. Tie these to the bottom of the ring. Tie a strand of beads to the top of the ring which already has a loop at the top for easy hanging.
