YOU WILL NEED

- Bella! At Last Paperz – Wild Thing – feather cardstock
- Embroidery hoop – bamboo 8 inch
- DMC – 6 stranded embroidery floss - 3011, 3013, 3041, 3043
- Sullivans - felt – moss green
- Double sided Satin Ribbon – army green 10 mm
- Sew Easy - quilters tape
- Lincraft PVA glue
- Needle
- Scissors
- Pencil

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1:

Unscrew embroidery hoop and separate. Using the inner hoop trace the outer circle on the cardstock. Cut circle and set aside.

Step 2:

Lay the inner hoop on table. Lay felt on top. Place outer hoop on top, push the hoops together, ensuring felt is taut [by pulling the felt]. Secure by screwing the hoop as tight as needed.

Step 3:

Cut lengths [20-25cm] of the quilters tape and place on felt, forming desired pattern. We used 3 vertical and 2 horizontal overlaying them in the bottom right quadrant.

Step 4:

Using the tape as a guide embroider [desired stitches/design] with the embroidery floss. We used a running stitch, alternating the khaki shades on the horizontal and the violet shades vertically.

Step 5:

Trim excess felt leaving 1cm border.

Step 6:

Glue the cardstock to the back of the hoop with PVA glue [tucking and hiding the felt border]. We used alligator clips to hold the cardstock in place while it dried.

Step 7:

Cut ribbon, 20 cm length of ribbon. Feed ribbon under screw and tie ends with a knot.



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
