DIFFICULTY •••

Approximate Time of Project: 2+ hour

MATERIALS

1m of bamboo batting 50cm x 4 different Christmas quilting fabrics 1m of backing fabric 5m of red ribbon


EQUIPMENT

Fabric scissors
Tape measure
Curved safety pins
Quilters pencil
Sewing machine
Pins


Note: Please read all instructions before starting the project. Prewash and iron all fabric before starting.

STEPS


 Measure 50cm from the bottom right hand corner and 50cm from the edge and place a mark at each point. Draw an arch to join the two points. Cut along the arc. Repeat for 3 other fabrics.



Draw an arch that is 8cm from the corner, cut away the fabric. Cut each 45 degree arch into two sections. You will now have 8 sections.



Sew each arch section to each other to create a circle shape but leave one seam unsewn.



- 4. Smooth out and lay the backing fabric with wrong side facing up on a large flat surface. Lay the bamboo batting on top of the backing fabric. Place circle right side up on top of the batting and smooth out any wrinkles.
- Starting at the centre of the circle and working outwards, place a curved safety pins through all layers. Trim excess backing fabric and batting to 3cm from the edge of the quilt top.
- Quilt as desired.
- 7. Trim off the excess backing fabric and batting.
- Fold and pin the ribbon over all raw edges of the quilt. Stitch the ribbon to the quilt.
- Cut two strips of 40cm ribbon. Pin each ribbon on opposite sides of the circle slit near the centre of the circle slit. Stitch in place.
