Knot Bag

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference	cm	36
Height (excluding handle)	cm	18

Yarn Required:

Lincraft Cakes	200g balls	1
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DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES:

A set of double-pointed 4.00mm knitting needles.

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.

Wool needle for grafting and sewing up.

TENSION:

18.5 sts and 26 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

This Bag is worked on smaller needles and at a firmer tension than usually recommended.

BAG

Using a set of 4.00mm needles, cast on 68 sts. Join into the round being careful not to twist cast on edge.

Knit every round until work measures 18cm from beg.

Handle:

Next round: K17, turn.

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cont on these 17 sts for Handle.

1st row (wrong side): K2, P13, K2.

2nd row: K17.

Rep last 2 rows until Handle measures 26cm, ending with a 1st row.

Graft these 17 sts to the next 17 sts still on the set of needles.

Loop Closure:

With right side facing and using a pair of 4.00mm needles, knit next 17 sts, turn.

Cont on these 17 sts for Loop Closure.

1st row (wrong side): K2, P13, K2.

2nd row: K17.

Rep last 2 rows until Loop Closure measures 14cm, ending with a 1st row.

Graft these 17 sts to rem 17 sts still on the set of needles.

FINISHING

Lie the Bag flat with the Loop Closure in front of the Handle, then join the bottom seam. Sew in all ends.

Pass the Loop Closure over the Handle to close the Bag.
