how to make

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES:

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles. Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

md = mitred decrease = sl 2 tog knitways, K1, p2sso. ssk = sl 2 separately and knitways, place left-hand needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog.

BLANKET

Using 3.25mm needles and C1, cast on 121 (241) sts. 1st row: K1, ssk, K9, yon, * K1, yon, K10, md, K10, yon, rep from * to last 13 sts, K1, yon, K9, K2tog, K1. 2nd row: Purl, noting to purl yon's through back loop. Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 20cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Using C2, cont in patt until work measures 40cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Using C3, cont in patt until work measures 60cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Basinette size only:

Repeat all three colours in patt until work measures 120cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

All sizes: Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends. If desired, block edges to ensure they sit flat.
