#### **DIFFICULTY** • • •

#### **CROCHET HOOK**

A 3.00mm crochet hook.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

Wool needle for sewing up. Lincraft siliconised stuffing premium soft fill. Lincraft wadding (optional). A stitch marker (optional).

#### **TENSION**

Tension is not important for this project.

#### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

mr = magic ring (alternatively 3ch, sl st into beg ch and dc into ring).

**fptr** = front post treble. **flo** = front loop only. **blo** = back loop only.

#### WAFFLE (make 2 - worked in turned rows. Ch at beg counts as st)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, make 27ch.

1st row: 1tr in 4th ch from hook. 1tr in each ch to end

**2nd row:** 3ch, turn, [1tr in each of next 3tr, fptr in next tr] 5 times, 1tr in each of next 3tr, 1tr in top of 3ch ... 25tr. **3rd row:** 3ch, turn, [fptr in each of next 3tr, 1tr in next tr] 5 times, fptr in each of next 3tr, 1tr in top of 3ch ... 25tr. 2nd and 3rd rows form patt.

Work 5 rows patt. 9th row: As 2nd row.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

With wrong sides tog, match up sts and sew around edges. Sew in all ends

#### **ICE CREAM SCOOP** (worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C1, work 6dc into mr.

**1st round:** Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

**2nd round:** [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc. 3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

**5th round:** [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 42dc

**7th round:** 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round twice.

**10th round:** [1dc in each of next 6dc, inc in next dc] 6

times ... 48dc.

11th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 11th round twice.

14th round: Worked in flo. [1dc in next dc, miss 2, 5tr in next dc, miss 2] 8 times, sl st to beg dc ... 56 sts.

**15th round:** Worked in blo from 13th round. 1ch, [1dc in each of next 6dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 42dc.

**16th round:** [1dc in each of next 5dc, 1dc over next 2dc]

6 times ... 36dc.

Beg to stuff.













17th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

18th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

19th round: [1dc over next 2dc] 12 times ... 12dc. 20th round: [1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 6dc. Fasten off. Complete stuffing. Weave tail through last few decs of round and pull hole closed.

#### **FINISHING**

Make scoops in C2 and C3. Get creative. Suggested decorating ideas include sewing on coloured beads for sprinkles, using C4 make French knots to create chocolate chips, sew on red pom poms for cherries. Sew in all ends.

#### **STRAWBERRY** (worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C5, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

**2nd round:** [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc. **3rd round:** [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 4th round once.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6

times ... 18dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round once.

9th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 12dc.

Beg to stuff.

**10th round:** 1dc in each dc to end.

**11th round:** [1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 6dc.

**12th round:** 1dc in each dc to end.

Fasten off. Complete stuffing. Weave tail through last few

decs of round and pull hole closed.

#### STRAWBERRY TOP

Using 3.00mm hook and C6, work 6dc into mr. **1st round:** [1dc in next dc, 6ch, sl st into base of ch] 6 times ... 6 6ch lps.

Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew Strawberry Top to top of Strawberry. Sew in all ends.

#### **CHOCOLATE SAUCE SPLAT (worked in** continuous spirals, then turned rows)

Using 3.00mm hook and C4, work 6dc into mr.

**1st round:** Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

**2nd round:** [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc. **3rd round:** [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

**5th round:** [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

Beg to work in turned rows. Ch does not count as st.

1st row: 1dc in each of next 5dc ... 5dc.

2nd row: 1ch, turn, 1dc in each of next 5dc ... 5dc. 3rd row: 1ch, turn, 1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc, 1dc

in each of next 2dc ... 4dc. 4th row: 1ch, turn, 1dc in each of next 4dc ... 4dc. 5th row: 1ch, turn, 1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc, 1dc

6th row: 1ch, turn, 1dc in each of next 3dc ... 3dc. 7th row: 1ch, turn, 1dc over next 2dc, 1dc in next dc, work 6dc evenly down edge of rows, 1dc in next dc from 5th round ... 9dc.

Rep 1st to 7th rows 5 times ... 6 'splats' created. Fasten off. Sew in all ends.

### **BANANA SLICE** (make 2 - worked in continuous

Using 3.00mm hook and C7, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

**2nd round:** [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc. **3rd round:** [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

in next dc ... 3dc.

Using length of MC, embroider Banana seed detail as desired. With wrong sides tog, sew around Banana edges. Sew in all ends













#### **BLUEBERRY** (worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C8, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

**2nd round:** [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

4th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times

... 12dc.

5th round: [1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 6dc.

Stuff.

**6th round:** [1sl st in next dc, 4ch, sl st into base of ch] 6

times ... 6 4ch lps.

Fasten off. Weave tail through decs of 5th round and pull

hole closed. Sew in all ends.
