MEASUREMENTS

| Plain Beret | 3 | 3 | 3 | 4 | 4 |  |

## DIFFICULTY

## NEEDLES:

A pair of 4.00 mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

## TENSION:

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 4.00 mm needles.

## STRIPED BERET:

Using 4.00 mm needles and C 1 , cast on 91 (93-95-99-101) sts.
1st row: K2, ${ }^{*}$ P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.
2nd row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.
Last 2 rows form rib.
Work a further 6 rows rib.
9th row: Using C2, K1, ${ }^{*}$ M1, K2, rep from * to end ... 136 (139-142-148-151) sts.
10th row: Purl.
Using C1 work 2 rows stocking st.
Using C3 work 2 rows stocking st.

## Beg Stripe Patt:

Working in stocking st throughout, work in stripes of 2 rows $\mathrm{C} 1,2$ rows $\mathrm{C} 2,2$ rows C 1 , then 2 rows C 3 .
Last 8 rows form stripe patt.
Cont in stripe patt until Beret measures 9 (10-12-13-14) cm from beg, ending with a knit row.

Next row: Purl and dec 5 (dec 8 -inc 2-dec 4-dec 7) sts evenly across ... 131 (131-144-144-144) sts.

## Shape Crown:

1st row: Keeping stripe patt correct, K1, * K2tog, K11, rep from * to end ... 121 (121-133-133-133) sts.
2nd and alt rows: Purl.
3rd row: K1, * K2tog, K10, rep from * to end.
5th row: K1, * K2tog, K9, rep from * to end.
7th row: K1, ${ }^{*}$ K2tog, K8, rep from * to end.
9th row: K1, ${ }^{*}$ K2tog, K7, rep from * to end.
11th row: K1, * K2tog, K6, rep from * to end.
13th row: K1, * K2tog, K5, rep from * to end.
15th row: K1, * K2tog, K4, rep from * to end.
17th row: K1, * K2tog, K3, rep from * to end.
19th row: K1, * K2tog, K2, rep from * to end.
21st row: K1, * K2tog, K1, rep from * to end.
23rd row: K1, * K2tog, rep from * to end.
24th row: P1 (1-0-0-0), * P2tog, rep from * to end ...
6 sts.
Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

## FINISHING

Join back seam. Sew in all ends.

## PLAIN BERET

Work as for Striped Beret but working in one colour throughout.
