MEASUREMENTS

Years		2-4	5-7	8-10	Lady	Man
To fit head	cm	52	53	55	56	59

Yarn Required:

Lincraft Double Knitting 8ply	100g balls	1	1	1	1	1
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DIFFICULTY ●●●

CROCHET HOOK:

A 4.00mm crochet hook.

REQUIREMENTS:

Wool needle for sewing up.

A pom pom maker (optional - available from Lincraft).

TENSION:

15tr and 9 rows to 10cm over tr, using 4.00mm hook.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

trblo = treble crochet through the back loop only.

NOTE:

Turning chain doesn't count as a stitch.

RIBBED BEANIE

Using 4.00mm hook, make 39 (41-45-49-53) ch.

1st row: 1tr in 4th ch from hook and each ch to end, turn ... 36 (38-42-46-50) tr.

2nd row: Ch3, trblo in each tr to end, turn.

Repeat last row until work measures 44 (46-46-48-50) cm from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a 70cm tail of yarn.

FINISHING:

Beanie is worked sideways - join beg and end edges. For crown, run yarn through every row of edge sts, gathering up tightly, stitching gap closed and and fasten off securely.

If desired, make a pom pom and attach to crown of Beanie.

Sew in all ends. Turn up brim.
