Crochet **Shopping Bag**





MEASUREMENTS			
Width (approx)	cm	30	
Yarn Required:			
Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls	5	

4th round: 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each of next 14dc, 1dc in each of next 110ch, 1dc in each of next 30dc, 1dc in each of next 110ch, 1dc in next 15dc, sl st into first dc.

5th round: 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each dc to end

Rep 5th round twice.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Turn Bag inside out and dc bottom edges tog. Fasten off. Sew in all ends.

DIFFICULTY • •

CROCHET HOOK:

A 4.00mm crochet hook.

REQUIREMENTS:

Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

BAG

Using 4.00mm hook, make 102ch and sl st into first ch to form a ring.

1st round: 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end, sl st into first dc. **2nd round:** 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each dc to end, sl st into first dc.

3rd round: 4ch (stands as 1tr, 1ch), [miss 1dc, 1tr in next dc] to end, sl st into 3rd of 4ch.

4th round: SI st into first 1ch sp, 5ch (stands as 1tr, 2ch), [1tr in next 1ch sp, 2ch] to end, sI st into 3rd of 5ch. **5th round:** SI st into first 2ch sp, 5ch (stands as 1tr, 2ch), [1tr in next 2ch sp, 2ch] to end, sI st into 3rd of 5ch. Rep 5th round 30 times or until length required.

Top Edge:

1st round: 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, [1dc in 2ch sp, 1dc in next tr] to end, sl st into first dc.

2nd round: 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each dc to end, sl st into first dc . . . 102dc.

3rd round: 1ch, 1dc in same place as sl st, 1dc in each of next 14dc, 110ch, miss next 21dc, 1dc in each of next 30dc, 110ch, miss next 21dc, 1dc in each of next 15dc, sl st into first dc

Height (approx, excluding handles)	cm	35
Circumference (approx)	cm	65
Yarn Required: Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls	3



DIFFICULTY ••

NEEDLES:

A set of 3.75mm double-pointed knitting needles. A 3.75mm circular knitting needle, 40cm long. A 5.00mm circular knitting needle, 40cm long. Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION:

23.5 sts and 32 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.75mm needles.

BAG

Base Of Bag:

Using a set of 3.75mm needles, cast on 6 sts. Place a marker at beg of round.

Note: Switch to a 3.75mm circular needle when sts no longer fit comfortably on the set.

1st round: Inc once in each st ... 12 sts.

2nd round: * K1, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 24 sts.

3rd and alt rounds: Knit.

4th round: * K2, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 36 sts. **6th round:** * K3, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 48 sts. **8th round:** * K4, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 60 sts.

10th round: * K5, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 72 sts. **12th round:** * K6, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 84 sts.

14th round: * K7, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 96 sts.

16th round: * K8, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 108 sts. **18th round:** * K9, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 120 sts.

20th round: * K10, yfwd, rep from * to end ... 120 sts.

Knit 6 rounds.

Body Of Bag:

Change to 5.00mm circular needle.

1st round: * K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to end.

2nd round: Knit.

Last 2 rounds form lace patt.

Cont in lace patt until Bag measures 30cm from beg of lace patt, ending with a 2nd round.

Upper Edge:

Change to 3.75mm circular needle.

1st round: Knit. 2nd round: Purl.

Rep last 2 rounds 3 times. Cast off loosely.

HANDLES

For Two Short Hand-Held Handles:

Using two of the 3.75mm double-pointed needles, knit up 8 sts along the Bag's cast off edge.

Working in rows, knit in garter st until Handle measures 15cm, or length desired, working last row on wrong side.

Sew Handle's cast off edge in position, to Bag's cast off edge. Make another Handle for the other side of the Bag.

For One Over The Shoulder Handle:

Using two of the 3.75mm double-pointed needles, knit up 12 sts along the Bag's cast off edge.

Working in rows, knit in garter st until Handle measures 50cm, or length desired, working last row on wrong side. Cast off.

Sew Handle's cast off edge in position, to Bag's cast off edge.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends.
