Tree Bow

DIFFICULTY ●●●

Approximate Time of Project: 15 mins

MATERIALS

Polyester netting (approx. 2.5 m per bow, see note)
Red yarn

EQUIPMENT

Scissors
Yarn needle

STEPS

1. Note: These instructions will make a bow that is approx. 40cm high x 30cm wide (not including the bow tails) and to wrap around a tree that is max 1.4m in circumference. If you wish to make a bigger bow – increase the width and length strips of netting in the bow and tails.

Cut out the following strips:

- Bow:
 - 5 long strips (140cm x 17cm)
 - 3 shorter strips that are (70cm x 14cm)
 - Small centre strip (8cm x 30cm)
 - Wrap around the tree:
 - 1 strip (140cm x 90cm)
2. Fold over the three shorter strips onto themselves to create a loop. Repeat for the three shorter strips.
 3. Lay the smaller loops together and place over the larger loops. Gather and secure netting in the centre with a yarn.
 4. Lay the gathered loops onto two long strips. Wrap a small length around the centre to secure the bow to the long strips.

5. Push down the tails of the bow and open out the loops. Cut triangles out of the ends of the tail of the bow.
6. Wrap netting around tree. Secure into place yarn.
7. Attach bow to netting with wool and yarn needle.
