Union Jack Cushion

DIFFICULTY ●●●

Approximate Time of project: 2 hours +

MATERIALS

50cm Red Felt
50cm Blue Felt
50cm White Felt
50cm of White Fabric
Matching thread
Heat n Seal
30 cm x 50cm cushion insert

EQUIPMENT

Scissors
Sewing machine
Iron
Hand sewing needle

STEPS

1. Cut out the following:
 - 50cm x 30cm rectangle of the blue felt.
 - Two 60cm x 6cm and two 50 cm x10cm of strips of white felt.
 - Four strips of 20cm x 2cm of red felt.
 - 50cm x 30cm rectangle of red felt and remove a 10cm high by 16cm wide rectangle in each corner to create an extended cross shape.
 - 50cm x 30cm of white fabric
2. Lay the white felt strips onto the blue felt as pictured and secure into place with Heat n Seal. Satin stitch around the edge the white felt with white thread.
3. Lay the red felt cross in the centre of the large white strips, secure into place with Heat n Seal. Satin stitch around the edge the red felt with red thread.
4. Place the small red strips on the diagonal white felt. Cut the strip edges closest to the red felt cross parallel to the cross as pictured. Secure strips into place with Heat n Seal. Satin stitch around the edge the red felt with red thread.
5. Cut off any extra fabric around the 30cm by 50cm blue felt.
6. With right sides together, sew 1.5cm from the edge of the cushion front and the white fabric leaving a 15cm gap on one side.
7. Clip the corners to reduce seam bulk and flip the cushion inside out.
8. Place the cushion insert into the cover and close the gap in the cover with an invisible stitch.
