



Patchwork Bunny Cushion

Intermediate

how to make

Patchwork Bunny Cushion #D013

DIFFICULTY

Intermediate - Approx. 2 hour

MATERIALS

- Multi Fuzzy Spring Fat Quarter pack x2
- Matching thread
- Lincraft cushion insert 40cm

EQUIPMENTS

- Sewing machine
- Fabric scissors
- Iron / Ironing board
- Rotary cutter
- Sullivans cutting mat
- Sullivans quilters square

STEPS

1. Use the Sullivans quilter ruler to cut 9 squares of the multi fuzzy spring fabric and 2 pieces of pink/white and pink sparkles fabric measuring 47cm by 30cm.

2. Lay the 9 squares in rows of 3 as shown.

3. Pin together first row and sew. Pin together second and third row and sew. Iron seams flat.

4. Pin together first row with second row and make sure the seams are matched up. Sew together. Repeat with third row.

5. Now you have one big square. Iron flat all the seams. Measure it and cut it into quarters. Flip the first and last square.

6. Pin and sew the 4 pieces back together.

7. Hem the 2 pieces of fabric that are for the back of the cushion.

8. Put the front and back of the cushion right sides together. Pin at the top and sew. Do the same for the other side. Now is the time to trim anything overhanging before you sew the sides together.

9. Pin the sides in place and sew. Turn the cushion right side out.
