Textured Throw
With Moss Stitch Edging

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	110
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Length (approx)	cm	110
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Yarn Required:

Lincraft Lombardi	100g balls	10
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DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES:

A pair of 10.00mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION:

7.5 sts and 11 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 10.00mm needles.

PANELS 1 AND 3 (make 2)

Using 10.00mm needles, cast on 19 sts.

** Work in stocking st for 25cm, ending with a purl row.

Knit in garter st for 25cm, working last row on wrong side. **

Rep from ** to ** once.

Cast off.

PANELS 2 AND 4 (make 2)

Using 10.00mm needles, cast on 19 sts.

*** Knit in garter st for 25cm, working last row on wrong side.

Work in stocking st for 25cm, ending with a purl row. ***

Rep from *** to *** once.

Cast off.

MOSS STITCH SIDE EDGING

Using a flat seam, join Panels tog.

Using 10.00mm needles, cast on 5 sts.

1st row: K1, [P1, K1] twice.

Last row forms moss st.

Cont in moss st until work is length required to fit along left side edge, working last row on wrong side.

Cast off in moss st.

Rep for right side edge.

Using a flat seam, sew both Side Edgings in position.

MOSS STITCH TOP EDGING

Using 10.00mm needles, cast on 5 sts.

Work in moss st until work is length required to fit along top edge, incl top of both Side Edgings, working last row on wrong side.

Cast off in moss st.

Rep for Bottom Edging.

FINISHING

Using a flat seam, sew Top and Bottom Edgings in position.

Sew in all ends.
