Cable Throw With
Garter Stitch Edging

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	106
Length (approx)	cm	106
Yarn Required:		
Lincraft Lombardi	100g balls	10

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES:

A 10.00mm circular knitting needle,
80cm or longer.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

REQUIREMENTS:

A cable needle.

TENSION:

10 sts and 11 rows to 10cm over cable patt, using
10.00mm needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C4B = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back
of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

C4F = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front
of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

THROW

Using 10.00mm circular needle, cast on 80 sts.

Note: A circular needle is used to accommodate the large
number of sts. Work backwards and forwards in rows,
not rounds.

Knit 5 rows garter st.

6th row: K5, * inc in next st, K2, rep from * to last 3 sts,
K3 ... 104 sts.

Beg Cable Patt:

1st row: Knit.

2nd and alt rows: K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

3rd row: K4, * C4B, K4, C4F, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

5th row: Knit.

7th row: K4, * K2, C4F, C4B, K2, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

8th row: As 2nd row.

Last 8 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until Throw measures approx 102cm from beg,
ending with an 8th row.

Next row: K5, * K2tog, K2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3
... 80 sts.

Knit 5 rows garter st.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends.
