## FABRIC CROWN

DIFFICULTY ●●●

Approximate Time of Project: 1 hour

### MATERIALS

Cotton fabric (in 2 colours)  
Thin wadding  
Thread  
Ribbon

### EQUIPMENT

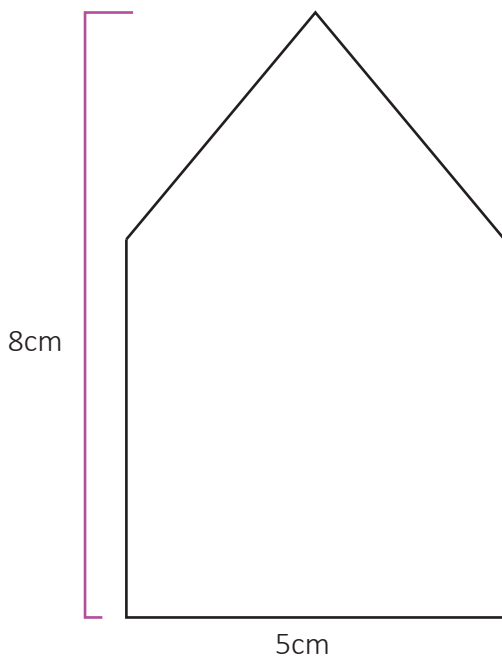
Scissors  
Pins  
Sewing machine  
Sewing needle

### HELPFUL HINTS

- When turning the project right side out use a knitting needle or pencil to get to the points.

### STEPS

1. Cut fabric to two 47x8cm rectangles.
2. Accordion fold fabric into 5cm sections, leaving 1cm seam allowance overhanging on both ends. Cut to a point using template.
3. Repeat for other colour.
4. Use the fabric to cut the wadding into the same shape.
5. Pin fabric right sides together with wadding on top.
6. Sew around edges leaving a gap on the straight to turn right side out. Trim curves and turn right side out.
7. Sew up the hole on the straight.
8. Cut 2 lengths of ribbon to 20cm.
9. Pin and sew ribbon to both ends of the crown.
10. Place crown on head and tie at the back.



## LION PIN

**DIFFICULTY** ●●●

**Approximate Time of Project:** 30 minutes

### MATERIALS

A4 felt (brown, orange and white)  
Embroidery floss (orange and brown)  
Thread  
Stuffing  
Safety pin

### EQUIPMENT

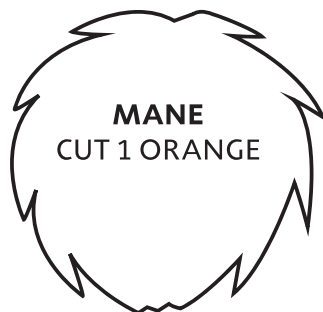
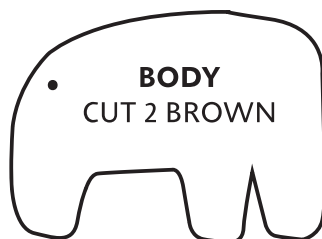
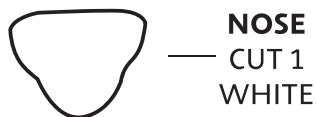
Embroidery needle

### HELPFUL HINTS

- Offcuts of felt can be used to stuff the lion if shredded into small pieces.

### STEPS

1. Cut out felt using templates.
2. Sew and stuff Body. Set aside.
3. Sew Nose to Head. Embroider eye and mouth details onto the lion's face using brown embroidery floss.
4. Sew Head to the middle of Mane and stuff as you go.
5. Sew Mane to Body.
6. Cut 4 lengths of orange embroidery floss to 10cm each. Thread onto needle and pull halfway through at end of Body. Knot and trim to even lengths.
7. Sew safety pin to the back of the lion.
8. Attach safety pin to shirt and secure when wearing.



## ROYAL CLOAK

DIFFICULTY ● ● ●

Approximate Time of Project: 30 minutes

### MATERIALS

1m red velvet  
1m grey velvet  
Thread  
Wide black ribbon  
Gold chain  
2 large gold buttons

### EQUIPMENT

Fabric scissors  
Pins  
Sewing machine  
Sewing needle

### STEPS

1. Cut both colours of velvet to 1x1.2m.
2. Pin right sides together and sew leaving at 10cm gap to pull through.
3. Turn right side out and sew up gap.
4. Cut 54cm of ribbon. Fold 2cm of raw ends under and sew down on wrong side..
5. Pin ribbon to the right side of the cloak (red side) gathering velvet evenly along the ribbon. Sew down.
6. Cut the chain to 40cm. Fold in half and sew ends to the inside of the ribbon.
7. Fold ribbon over and hand sew the long side to the grey velvet to hide gathering.
8. Sew gold buttons to the outside ends of the ribbon.
9. Drape cloak over shoulders and loop the end of chain over opposite button to wear.
