## DIFFICULTY ●●●

**Approximate Time of Project:** 2+ hours

## MATERIALS

1 ball Lincraft Spaghetti yarn  
2 x 250mm craft rings  
A4 felt  
Yarn (similar colour to felt)

## EQUIPMENT

7mm crochet hook  
Wool needle  
Pegs

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

**mr** = magic ring (alternatively 5 ch, sl st into beg ch and tr into ring)

## STEPS

1. Crochet 2 circles using the following instruction or the template attached.

Using 7.00mm crochet hook, make a mr.

**1st row:** 1ch (don't count as stitch throughout pattern), 8dc into mr, sl st in beg ch to join...8 sts.

**2nd row:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, [2dc in each st] 7 times, sl st in beg ch...16 sts.

**3rd row:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1 dc in next st, [2dc in first st, 1dc in next st] to end, sl st in beg ch...24 sts.

**4th round:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 2 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 2 sts] to end, sl st in beg ch...32 sts.

**5th round:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 3 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 3 sts] to end, sl st in beg ch...40 sts.

**6th round:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 4 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 4 sts] to end, sl st in beg ch...48 sts.

**7th round:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 5 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 5 sts] to end, sl st in beg ch...56 sts.

**8th round:** 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 6 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 6 sts] till 56 stitches, 1ch, sl st in next st. Fasten off.

**9th round:** Join yarn to beg ch of 8th round. 1ch, 2dc in same st, 1dc in next 7 sts, [2dc in first st, 1dc in each of next 7 sts] til 63 stitches, 1ch, sl st in stitch below. Fasten off.  
Sew in all ends

2. Whip stitch the edge of the crochet circle onto the ring. Repeat with other ring and crochet circle.
3. Make chain 50cm long and attach each end to a ring 10cm down from handle openings.
4. Cut felt rectangle to 45x14cm.
5. Starting at the beginning of the joined chain and working around the bag, stitch the edge of the felt to the ring so the seam sits inside the bag.
6. Repeat this on the other ring with the other edge of the felt rectangle.
7. Fold felt inside bag and clamp the bottom of the bag shut using pegs.
8. Using the Spaghetti yarn sew 15cm of the bottom of the rings together to act as a hinge.
9. Sew in all ends.
