

Grasslands Bunny Rug

This delightful crochet blanket is warm and cuddly and will keep your child company for years to come. The pattern uses double crochet stitches with an easy to read colour graph to create a cute bunny, complete with pom-pom tail. All of the yarns recommended for this project are also soft enough for little ones and easy to care for.

MEASUREMENTS

Size		Pram	Swaddle	Cot
Width	cm	75	100	100
Length (approx)	cm	100	100	150
Yarn Required: Lincraft Grasslands 8ply	50g balls			
OR Lincraft Baby 8ply Merino	50g balls			
Main Colour (M)		16	18	25
Constrast Colour (C)		2	2	3
OR Makr Baby Soft 8ply	100g balls			
Main Colour (M)		8	9	13
Contrast Colour (C)		1	1	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY •••

CROCHET HOOK AND EQUIPMENT:

A 4.50mm crochet hook.

Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

18 sts and 22 rows to 10cm over double crochet, using 4.50mm hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

ch: chain

dc: double crochettr: treble crochetst: stitch

BLANKET (REFER TO ITEM A)

Using M and 4.50mm hook, ch 135 (181-181).

Row 1: 1dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1dc into each ch to end of row, turn ...

134 (180-180) sts.

Row 2: Ch1, 1dc into each dc to end of row, turn.

Repeat last row until Blanket measures 10 (10-15) cm.

Cont working as 2nd row and AT SAME TIME begin to follow graph, on next page, allowing for 18 (18-28) sts in M along right edge before graph begins.

NOTE: When following colour graph for this pattern, carry the unused main yarn under working contrast yarn.

Cont working as 2nd row in M once graph is complete, until Blanket measures 100 (100-150) cm.

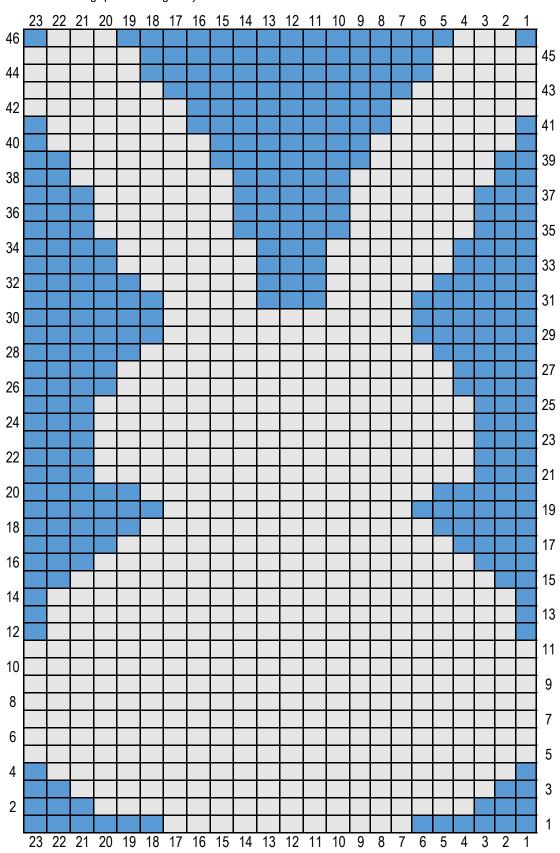
FINISHING

Using M, work a picot border - Join yarn to corner. 1ch, 1dc into same st, * 3ch, sl st into 3rd ch from hook, miss 1st, 1dc into next st, rep from *

Fasten off. Sew in all ends.

Using C, make a pom pom and attach to the tail of the bunny.
