

COTTON 8PLY YARN Ladies Kimono Sleeve Jacket INTERMEDIATE CROCHET **#P004** 

Crafted from our Cotton 8ply, this Kimono sleeve jacket can be worn as a beach coverup or styled with jeans for a casual summer look. This pattern features minimal shaping, a dropped shoulder and statement granny triangle pockets. Alternatively, work it all in one colour to have a versatile garment for your day-to-day wardrobe.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## DIFFICULTY •••

## **CROCHET HOOK AND EQUIPMENT:**

A 4.00mm crochet hook. Wool needle for sewing in ends.

## **TENSION:**

14 sts and 10 rows to 10cm over offset treble pattern, using 4.00mm hook.

# **CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:**

- ch:
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet

chain

dtrCL: \*yrh twice, insert yarn in same sp, pull yarn through work, yrh, pull yarn through 2 loops, rep from \* until 9 loops on hook, yrh, pull through all 9 loops, 1ch.

# JACKET

#### Back:

Using M and 4.00mm hook, ch 82 (90-98-106).

**Row 1:** 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr in each ch to end, turn ... 80 (88-96-104) sts.

**Row 2:** 3ch (counts as tr), 1tr in each sp between previous row sts to end, turn.

Last row forms offset treble patt.

Continue in patt until Back measures 31cm. Tie contrast yarn on both sides to mark armholes.

Continue in patt for 22 (24-24-26) rows. Fasten off.

## Front (Make 2 alike):

Using M and 4.00mm hook, ch 38 (**40**-44-**48**). Row 1: 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr in each ch to end, turn ... 36 (**38**-42-**46**) sts. Row 2: 3ch (counts as tr), 1tr in each sp between previous row sts to end, turn.

Last row forms offset treble patt.

Cont in patt until Front measures 31cm.

#### **Front Neck Shaping:**

Row 1: 3ch (counts as tr), 1tr in each sp between previous row sts to last 2 sps, tr2tog into last 2 sps, turn. Row 2: 3ch (counts as tr), 1tr in each sp between previous row sts to end, turn. Continue in patt, dec on every alt row until 26 (28-30-32) sts rem. Then work even until Front is the same length as the Back

Then work even until Front is the same length as the Back. Fasten off.

## **SLEEVES:**

Using M and 4.00mm hook, ch 66 (**70**-74-**78**). **Row 1:** 1tr into 4th ch from hook, 1tr in each of ch to end, turn... 64 (**68**-72-**76**).sts. **Row 2:** 3ch (counts as tr), 1tr in each sp between previous row sts to end, turn. Last row forms offset treble patt.

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Cont in patt until Sleeve measures 33cm.

#### **Beg Cuff:**

Row 1: Using C1, work 3ch, 2tr into first st, \*miss 3 sts, 3tr into next st\* to end of row, 1tr into top of turning ch of previous row.
Row 2: Using C2, work 3ch, 2tr into first sp, \*miss 3tr, 3tr into next sp\* to end of row, 1tr into top of turning ch of previous row.
Rep last row four more times, swapping colours each row (M, C1, C2, M).

Fasten off. Sew in ends.

#### POCKETS

Using MC and 4.00mm hook, 6ch and join with a sl st to form a ring. **Round 1:** 6ch (counts as tr and 3ch throughout), [3tr in ring, 3ch] twice, 2tr in ring. Sl st in top of 3rd ch to join. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Join C1 to same 3ch sp, 6ch, 3tr in same sp, [1ch, (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) in next sp] twice, 1ch, 2tr in beg sp. Sl st in top of 3rd ch to join. Fasten off. **Round 3:** Join C2 to same 3ch sp, 6ch, 3tr in same sp, [1ch, 3tr in next sp, 1ch (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) in next sp] twice, 1ch, 3tr in next sp, 1ch, 2tr in beg sp. Sl st in top of 3rd ch to join. Fasten off. **Round 4:** Join M, sl st into beg 3ch sp. Continue around triangle working (1ch, 3tr) into 1ch spaces and (3tr, 3ch, 3tr) into 3ch spaces. Work 4 more rounds, swapping colours each round (C1, C2, M, C1).

Fasten off. Sew in all ends.

## FINISHING

Lay two Fronts side by side on top of Back with WS facing. Join along shoulder seams. Align centre top of sleeve with shoulder seam and join Sleeve to Body (between yarn markers). Seam sleeves and sides of Body.

With RS facing, join C1 at hem near Left side seam. Work 3tr into every 3rd stitch around the hem of Body, every 2nd row of the Right Front, every 3rd stitch of the Back Neck, every 2nd row of Left Front and every 3rd stitch along hem to start. SI st to join.

Work 4 rows as 2nd row of Sleeve Cuff, swapping colours each round (C2, M, C1, C2, M).

Fasten off. Sew in ends.
