Slouchy Jumper

INTERMEDIATE KNIT

Crafted from our chunky Chloe yarn, this sweater is cosy to wear in winter but being a cotton blend, it's breathable enough to be worn all year round! The jumper features an oversized fit, dropped shoulder and textured stripes. The pattern is quick to knit up, uses simple techniques and minimal shaping to create a gorgeous statement piece for your wardrobe.

MEASUREMENTS

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES:

A pair of 10.00mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.
2 stitch holders.

TENSION:

10 sts and 14 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 10.00mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit
K2tog: Knit 2 Together
Kfb: K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle and slide the stitch off the needle
P: Purl
P2tog: Purl 2 Together
Pfb: Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1
Sl1: Slip One Stitch purlwise
wyif: With Yarn in Front
wyib: With Yarn in Back

BACK

Using a pair of 10.00mm needles and C, cast on 55 (61-65-71) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Using C, Knit.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: Using M, Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 1-8 form stripe pattern.

Cont stripe patt sequence 7 more times (Back should measure approx. 42cm from beg), finishing on an 8th row.

Place a marker at each end of last row for armholes, as there is no armhole shaping. **

Using M, cont in st st until Back measures 58 (59-60-61) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 7 (8-8-9) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 6 (6-8-8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Leave rem 15 (17-17-19) sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Using M, cont in st st until there are 8 (10-10-12) rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Neck:

Row 1 (RS): K23 (26-28-31), turn.
Cont on these 23 (26-28-31) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 20 (22-24-26) sts rem.
Work 1 row.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 7 (8-8-9) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 (6-8-8) sts.

Slip next 9 sts onto a stitch holder.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts and knit to end.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 20 (22-24-26) sts rem.

Work 2 rows.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 7 (8-8-9) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 (6-8-8) sts.

SLEEVES

Using a pair of 10.00mm needles, cast on 27 (29-31-33) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Using C, Knit.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: Using M, Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 1-8 form stripe pattern.

Cont stripe patt sequence, inc one st at each end of next row, then every 4th row until there are 39 (43-47-51) sts.

Cont stripe patt without shaping until Sleeve measures 35cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Using M, cont in st st until Sleeve measures 41cm from beg (or length desired), working last row on wrong side.

Cast off.

NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing, using M and 10.00mm circular needle, beg at left shoulder seam and knit up 12 (14-14-16) sts along left front neck, [K4, K2tog, K3] across front stitch holder, knit up 12 (14-14-16) sts along right front neck, then [K7 (8-8-9), K2tog, K6 (7-7-8)] across sts from back neck stitch holder ... 46 (52-52-58) sts.

1st round: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round 3 times.

Cast off loosely in rib.

FINISHING

Sew in sleeves evenly between markers, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.
