Seed Stitch Cushion Cover

EASY KNIT

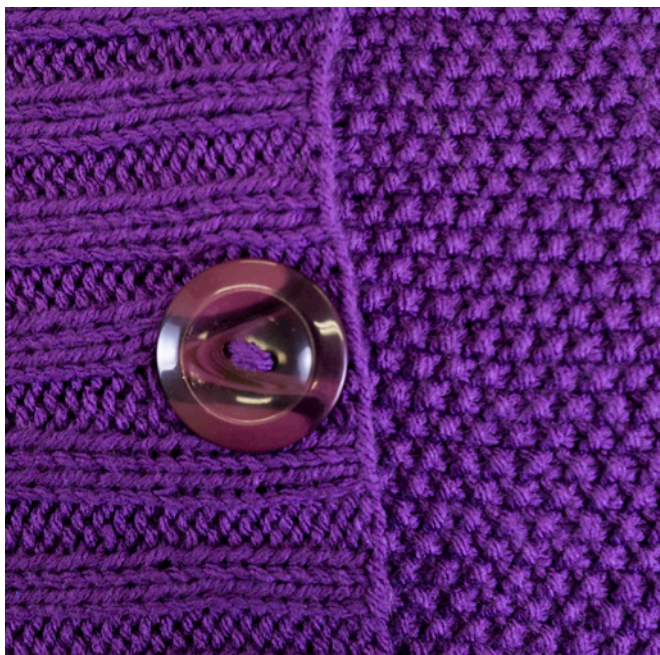
This cushion uses the simple and effective combination of seed and rib stitches to create visual texture. With a three button closure, this cushion cover is removable and easy to wash. Brighten up your sofa or bed with bold, statement colours from our Colourmate 10ply range.

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	45
Length (approx)	cm	45
Yarn Required:		
Makr Colourmate 10ply	200g balls	2

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

ITEM A: Seed Stitch & Button Detail



DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 5.00 mm knitting needles.
Wool Needle for sewing in ends.
Stitch holder.
Lincraft Cushion Insert - Size 18, 45cm x 45cm.
3 buttons.

TENSION:

15 sts to 26 rows over 10cm over seed st using 5.00 mm knitting needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit
K2tog: Knit 2 Together
P: Purl
P2tog: Purl 2 Together
YO: Yarn Over

PILLOW

Button Stand:

Using 5.00mm needles, cast on 68 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *K2, P2, repeat from * to end.

This rows form a 2x2 rib pattern, repeat seven more times ... 8 rows

Seed Stitch Pattern:

Row 9 (RS): *K1, P1, repeat from * to end

Row 10: *P1, K1, repeat from * to end

Row 9 and 10 form a seed st pattern, continue working in seed st until piece measures 70 cm from beg.

Button Overlay:

Return to working in 2x2 rib and keep working in rib until piece measures, 21 cm from beginning of ribbing section ending on a WS row.

Buttonholes:

Next row (RS): (K2, P2) 4 times, K2, place remaining 50 sts on a stitch holder, turn and work on these 18 sts only. Work in rib keeping pattern correct for 4 more rows. Place these sts on a second st holder. Cut yarn.

** Sl the next 16 sts in the row off the stitch holder onto your needles, leaving the remaining 34 sts, rejoin the yarn to the RS of the ribbing and work in pattern established to end. Work 4 more rows of rib, cut yarn. Place these sts on the second st holder with the 18 sts worked earlier. ***

Repeat from ** to *** once more ... 18 sts left on first st holder. Rejoin yarn to work and (P2, K2) 4 times, P2 on rem sts and work in rib for 4 more rows ... 4 buttonholes made

Place all sts back onto working needles and work a WS row. Work in 2x2 rib until ribbing measures 25cm from beginning. Cast off in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Attach buttons to cushion cover.
