Fabric Carrots

## DIFFICULTY ●●●

**Approximate Time of Project:** 10 min (per carrot)

## MATERIALS

Assorted fabric (green and orange)  
Thread (complementary to fabric)  
Soft fill stuffing  
Ribbon

## EQUIPMENT

Fabric scissors  
Pins  
Sewing machine  
Embroidery needle

## HELPFUL HINTS

Use a knitting needle or a pencil to help turn the leaves right side out.

## STEPS

1. Cut out the orange fabric using the cone template and ten 3x6cm lengths from the green fabric.
2. Fold a green length in half with right sides together. Pin and sew long sides together. Turn right side out. Repeat for the other nine lengths.
3. Evenly space the green leaves on the right side of the orange piece, raw edges lined up. Pin and sew the leaves down leaving a 1cm gap at either end.
4. Fold the green leaves up away from the orange piece. Fold the curved orange hem over, pin and topstitch over the orange and raw leaf ends.
5. Fold the orange fabric in half, right sides touching, so the straight edges touch. Pin and sew along the straight line. Turn right side out.
6. Stuff the cone using the soft fill.
7. Cut 30cm of ribbon. Wrap and knot it securely around the topstitching cinching in the carrot top. Tie the ribbon ends into a bow to finish.
