Easter Tree

Approximate Time of Project: 30 min

MATERIALS

Refillable plastic Easter eggs
Decofoam sphere
Hot glue
1cm Dowel
Cord
Metal tin
Rocks
Crimped paper
Large ribbon

EQUIPMENT

Hot glue gun

STEPS

1. Stick the dowel into the middle of the sphere to create a hole. Remove the dowel and fill the hole with hot glue then stick the dowel back in to secure in the foam.
2. Click all the plastic eggs together so they are whole. Squeeze hot glue to the rounded bottom of the egg and hold it against the foam sphere until the glue is dry.
3. Continue to glue eggs to the sphere as close together as possible until the whole foam sphere is covered. Glue bunches of crimped paper in between gaps in eggs so foam can't be seen.
4. Wrap the cord around the tin gluing as you go until the tin is covered in cord.
5. Fill the tin with rocks and stick dowel in so the egg-covered top sits upright. Cover the top of the rocks with crimped pastel paper.
6. Tie a large ribbon around the tin and tie a bow in it.
7. Place the tree around the house to decorate for Easter. Pop open the plastic eggs to fill with chocolate for Easter morning.
