# how to make

## Lincraft

## YOU WILL NEED

- Fabric colour of choice backing and wedges – we used printed plisse assorted [tutu fruitti] – 30cm
- Cotton Homespun white 25cm
- Sullivans Iron-on interfacing

  heavy weight
- Sew-Easy cotton batting
- Gutterman thread matching colour – we used 1756
- Gutterman thread contrasting colour we used 364
- Double sided tape 9mm
- Scissors
- Pins

## INSTRUCTIONS

#### Step 1:

Cut the backing fabric panel - 27cm x 27cm.

#### Step 2:

Cut the front panel – cotton homespun – 27cm x 27cm.

#### Step 3:

Cut batting – 27cm x 27cm.

#### Step 4:

Cut out templates – trace larger ones onto fabric [8 times] and the smaller one onto the interfacing [8 times].

#### Step 5:

Iron the interfacing onto the wrong side of the wedges.

#### Step 6:

Fold seam and iron.

#### Step 7

Measure centre on cotton homespun fabric and sew wedge with matching colour.

#### Step 8:

Sew all wedges onto cotton homespun leaving a small gap between each wedge. Pull all threads through to wrong side.

#### Step 9:

Create sandwich by laying the backing fabric – wrong side uppermost. Then lay batting and then the white/wedges – right side uppermost.

#### Step 10:

Pin sandwich together to keep in place.

#### Step 11:

Sew vertical lines with contrasting colour using double side tape as a guide leaving a 2cm border.

#### Step 12:

Pull all threads to the back, secure and sew into sandwich to hide threads.

#### Step 13:

Carefully trim 2cm border of the cotton homespun and batting only.

## Step 14:

Fold backing fabric to the front - 1cm and then

Increase template by 550% to 16.5cm wide
