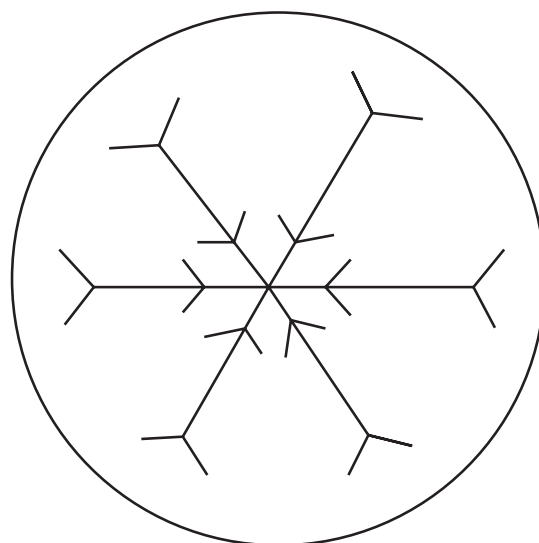

## YOU WILL NEED

- Sullivan - felt - white
- Sew Easy - wipe off fine line fabric marker
- DMC 816, white 3865
- Seed beads - size 12 [29305], weight 22g [29170] both red
- Ribtex 20mm shepherd hooks - dark silver
- Sullivans - Brooch pin
- Wadding
- Scissors
- Needle
- Template
- Pliers

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1:** Cut 4, 1.5 inch circles and 2, 2.5 inch circles.

**Step 2:** Draw snowflake on 2 of the 1.5 inch circles with fabric marker.

**Step 3:** Using one strand of DMC thread, starting in the centre, from back to front, sew onto thread 8 seed beads.

**Step 4:** Sew in place creating the first point of the snowflake.

**Step 5:** Continue sewing 8 beads to create the next 5 points of the snowflake. Thread 2 strands onto the needle, tie 4 ends together. Bring needle from back to front at the mid-way point of one of the points.

**Step 6:** Sew straight stitch.

**Step 7:** Bring needle back to the front just near the end of the straight stitch.

**Step 8:** Sew a French knot in this position.

**Step 9:** See a straight stitch and French knot on the other side of the beads.

**Step 10:** Repeat the same stitches at the end of the first point of the snowflake. Repeat until entire snowflake has been embroidered.

**Step 11:** Place beaded/embroidered piece on top of second felt piece. Sew together using white DMC thread with blanket stitch. Any visible marker pen can be erased with a damp paint brush.

**Step 12:** Sew the earring in between 2 blanket stitches. Close loop with pliers.

**Step 13:** With 1 strand of DMC sew the 22g seed beads onto the 2.5-inch circle.

**Step 14:** Continue sewing beads randomly but from the centre outwards.

**Step 15:** Sew beads to create desired design/effect.

**Step 16:** Sew size 12 seed beads around the centre beads.

**Step 17:** Sew some beads in a scattered format.

**Step 18:** Cut a 2-inch circle of wadding. Lay one 2.5 in circle of felt, piece of wadding and beaded piece.

**Step 19:** Sew together with white DMC thread and blanket stitch. Also sew the brooch pin in the middle of the back.
