INTERMEDIATE KNIT

We love the combination of this serpentine-like lace stitch with our luxuriously soft Ficio Organic Cotton. This pattern features a raglan sleeve with an easy fit through the body. With twisted rib and beautiful fashioning details through the sleeve seams, this sweater is sure to become an heirloom piece in your family. Our model is shown here wearing the 2yo size.

MEASUREMENTS

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

ITEM A: Back of Sweater



DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.
A pair of 3.75mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

20.5 sts and 28 rows over 10cm in lace work pattern, using 4.00mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit
K2tog: Knit 2 Together
K3tog: Knit 3 Together
Patt: Work in the pattern established according to the row
P: Purl
P2tog: Purl 2 Together
P2togtbl: Purl 2 Together through the back loop
Sl1: Slip One Stitch purlwise
wyif: With Yarn in Front
wyib: With Yarn in Back
ssk: Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)

BACK PULLOVER

NOTE: This pattern is written for our 1 year old size, all stitch counts and references for other sizes are written in brackets for easy reference. They are as follows, 1yo (2yo - 4yo - 6yo)

Ribbing:

Using 3.75mm knitting needles and cast on 56 (63 - 70 - 77) sts.

1 year old and 4 year old only:

Row 1 (RS): *Ktbl, P1, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: *K1, Ptbl, repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 1 & 2 form a twisted rib pattern.

2 year old and 6 year old only:

Row 1 (RS): *Ktbl, P1, repeat from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: P1, *K1, Ptbl, repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 1 & 2 form a twisted rib pattern.

All Sizes:

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 4 (4 - 5 - 5) cm from the beg ending with a RS row.

Main Panel:

Continue working with M and change to 4.00mm needles. Place a marker after the 3 (0 - 3 - 0) sts and last 4 (0 - 4 - 0) sts, working the pattern below between the markers. Work without shaping until piece measures 20 (22 - 24 - 26) cm from the beginning or the length desired, measuring to the underarm, ending with a WS row

Row 1 (RS): P3, K4 *P3, K4, P3, K4, repeat from * end.

Row 2: *P4, K3, P4, K3 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.

Row 3: As row 1

Row 4: A row 2

Row 5: P3, K4, *P2, K2tog, K3, YO, P3, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 6: *P4, K3, P5, K2, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 7: P3, K4, *P1, K2tog, K3, YO, K1, P3, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 8: *P4, K3, P6, K1, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 9: P3, K4, *K2tog, K3, YO, K2, P3, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 10: *P4, K3, P7 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 11: P3, K3, K2tog *K3, YO, K3, P3, K3, K2tog, repeat from * to last 14 sts, K3, YO, K3, P3, K4.
Row 12: *P4, K3, P7 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 13: P3, K2, K2tog, K1 *K2, YO, K4, P3, K2, K2tog, K1, repeat from * to last 14 sts, K2, YO, K4, P3, K4.
Row 14: *P4, K3, P4, K1, P2, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 15: P3, K1, K2tog, K2 *K1, YO, P1, K4, P3, K1, K2tog, K2, repeat from * to last 14 sts, K1, YO, P1, K4, P3, K5
Row 16: *P4, K3, P4, K2, P1, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 17: P3, K2tog, K3, *YO, P2, K4, P3, K2tog, K3, repeat from * to last 14 sts, YO, P2, K4, P3, K5.
Row 18: *P4, K3, P4, K3, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 19: P3, K4 *P3, K4, P3, K4, repeat from * end
Row 20: *P4, K3, P4, K3 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 21: As Row 19
Row 22: As Row 20
Row 23: P3, K4, *P3, YO, K3, SSK, P2, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 24: *P4, K2, P5, K3, repeat from * last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 25: P3, K4, *P3, K1, YO, K3, SSK, P1, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 26: *P4, K1, P6, K3, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 27: P3, K4, *P3, K2, YO, K3, SSK, K4, repeat from * to end.
Row 28: *P11, K3, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 29: P3, K4, *P3, K3, YO, K3, SSK, K3, repeat from * to end.
Row 30: *P11, K3, repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 31: P3, K4, *P3, K4, YO, K3, SSK, K2, repeat from * to end
Row 32: *P6, K1, P4, K3 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
Row 33: P3, K4, *P3, K4, P1, YO, K3, SSK, K1, repeat from * to end.
Row 34: *P5, K2, P4, K3, repeat from * to last 7 st, P4, K3.
Row 35: P3, K4, *P3, K4, P2, YO, K3, SSK, repeat from * to end.
Row 36: *P4, K3, P4, K3 repeat from * to last 7 sts, P4, K3.
 Repeat rows 1-36 for lace pattern taking care to work pattern between markers only for 2 year old and 4 year old size.

Raglan Armholes:

Continuing to work in the pattern established, removing the markers as you come to them, cast off 2 (2 - 2 - 3) sts at the beginning of the next two rows ... 52 (59 - 66 - 71) sts.

Next Row: Patt2, SSK, work in pattern to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2
Work 2 rows.

Next Row: Patt2, P2tog, work in pattern to last 4 sts, P2togtbl, Patt2
Work 2 rows... 48 (55 - 62 - 67) sts ***

Next Row: Patt2, SSK, work in pattern to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2
Work in pattern for 1 row.
Repeat the last two rows, 13 (15 - 19 - 21) more times ... 20 (23 - 22 - 23) sts remaining

Leave remaining sts on a st holder.

FRONT PULLOVER

Front Raglans:

Work until *** in the same manner as the back... 48 (55 - 62 - 67) sts

Next Row: Patt2, SSK, work in pattern to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2
Work in pattern for one row.
Repeat the last two rows, 6 (7 - 8 - 9) times more ... 34 (39 - 44 - 47) sts

Neck Shaping:

Row 1 (RS): Patt2, SSK, Patt 6 (8 - 8 - 10) turn. Place the rem 24 (27 - 32 - 33) sts on a st holder ... 9 (11 - 11 - 13) sts

Row 2-4: Work in pattern established to end

Row 5: Patt2, SSK, Patt to last three sts, K2tog, K1 ... 7 (9 - 9 - 11) sts

Row 6: Work in pattern established to end.
Repeat rows 5 & 6, 0 (1 - 1 - 2) times more ... 7 sts

Next Row: Patt2, K3tog, K1 ... 5 sts

Next Row: Work in pattern established to end

Next Row: K1, K3tog, K1 ... 3 sts.

Next Row: P3

Next Row: K1, SSK.

Next Row: P2

Next Row: SSK and fasten off.

Left Hand Neck Shaping:

With RS facing, sl the next 14 (15 - 20 - 19) sts onto a st holder for the front neck.

Join the yarn to the remaining sts, ready to work a RS row,

Row 1 (RS): Work to last four sts, K2tog, Patt2.

Row 2-4: Work in pattern established to end

Row 5: K1, SSK, Patt to last four sts, K2tog, Patt2.

Row 6: Work in pattern established to end.

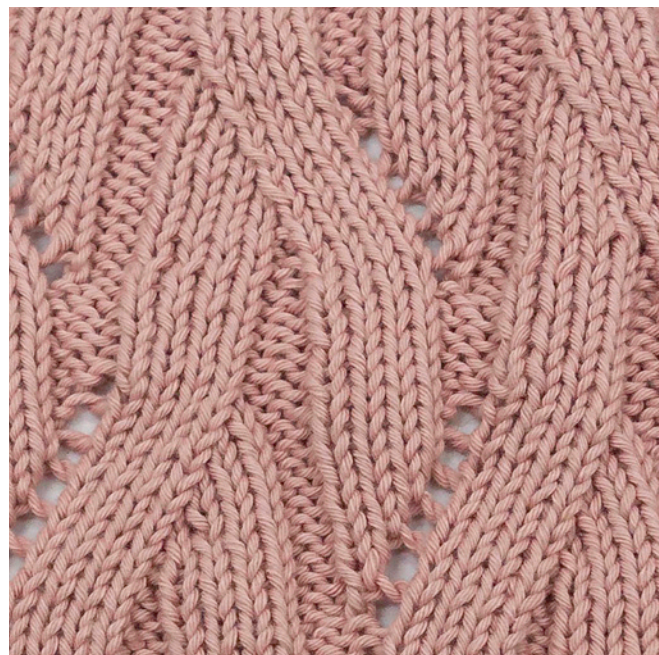
Repeat rows 5 & 6, 0 (1 - 1 - 2) times more ... 7 sts

Next Row: Patt2, K3tog, K1 ... 5 sts

Next Row: Work in pattern established to end

Next Row: K1, K3tog, K1 ... 3 sts.

ITEM B: Lacework Stitch Detail



Next Row: P3

Next Row: K2tog, K1..

Next Row: P2

Next Row: K2tog and fasten off.

SLEEVES

Cuff:

With 3.75mm needles, cast on 38 (38 - 42 - 42) sts.

Row 1 (RS): *Ktbl, P1, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: *K1, Ptbl, repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 1 & 2 form a twisted rib pattern.

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until piece measures 5 (5 - 5 - 6) cm in twisted rib as ending with a RS row.

Work one more row in ribbing, increasing evenly by 3 sts across the last row.

Arm:

Changing to 4.00mm needles, begin to work in stocking st for 8 rows.

Increase by 1 st at each end of the next row and on every following 4th row until there are 51 (49 - 51 - 53) sts

ITEM E: Lorem ipsum dolor sit amet, consectetur adipiscing elit.

Sizes 4 & 6 Only:

Increase by 1 st at each end of the next row and the following 6th row until there are (57 - 63) sts.

All Sizes:

Continue working in stocking st until work measures 19 (21 - 24 - 26.5) cm from the beginning ending with a WS row.

Shape Raglans:

Cast off 2 (2 - 3 - 3) sts at the beg of the next two rows ... 46 (45 - 51 - 57) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, SSK, knit to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Row 2: P2, P2tog, Purl to last 4 sts, P2togtbl, P2

Row 3 & 4: Work in stocking st

Row 5: K2, SSK, Knit to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Row 6: Work in stocking st.

Repeat these six rows 0 (1 - 2 - 1) times more ... 40 (33 - 39 - 51) sts

Next Row: K2, SSK, Knit to last four sts, K2tog, K2.

Next Row: Purl all.

Repeat these 2 rows until 8 (9 - 9 - 11) sts remain.

Leave the remaining sts on a st holder.



FINISHING

Sew together raglan seams, leaving left back raglan seam open.

Neckband:

With RS facing and smaller needles, K8 (9 - 9 - 11) sts from Left Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at centre. Pick up and knit 12 (12 - 13 - 13) sts down Left Front neck edge. K14 (15 - 20 - 19) sts from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 12 (12 - 13 - 13) sts up Right Front neck edge. K8 (9 - 9 - 11) sts from Right Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at centre. 20 (23 - 22 - 23) sts from Back st holder, dec 0 (0-0-2) sts evenly across ... 72 (78 - 84 - 86) sts in work.

Beginning with a WS row, work 9 rows in twisted rib as given for the sleeves. Cast off loosely in ribbing.

Sew left back raglan and neckband seam. Sew side and sleeve seams, weave in all ends, steam lightly and stretch gently into shape.
