YARN

Brickwork Lace Shawl

INTERMEDIATE KNIT

We've combined our lustrous Starburst yarn and a beautiful geometric lace stitch to create a statement wrap. With a pebbly, seed stitch border and rectangular shape, this wrap is versatile enough to be used as a pram cover or for modesty when breast feeding.

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	57
Length (approx)	cm	150
Yarn Required:		
Ficio Starburst	100g balls	3

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A 3.75mm circular knitting needle, 80cm.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.
Stitch Markers.

TENSION (AFTER BLOCKING):

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over brickwork lace pattern, using 3.75mm needles.

TENSION (AFTER BLOCKING):

24 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over seed stitch using 3.75mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K:	Knit
K2tog:	Knit 2 Together
Kfb:	K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle and slide the stitch off the needle
P:	Purl
P2tog:	Purl 2 Together
Pfb:	Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1
Sl1:	Slip One Stitch purlwise
wyif:	With Yarn in Front
wyib:	With Yarn in Back
SSK:	Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)
PSSO:	Pass slip stitch over

SHAWL

NOTE: A circular knitting needle is used here instead of a standard pair of needles to manage the large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows, do not join to work in the round.

Border:

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 124 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1, repeat from * to end.

Row 2: *P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

These two rows form a seed stitch pattern.

Work in seed stitch until the piece measures 5cm from the beg ending with a RS Row.

Next Row (WS): Work in seed st across the first six stitches, place a marker. Purl across to the last six sts, decreasing by 9 sts evenly across this section, work in seed st until end ... 115 sts

Brickwork Lace Pattern:

Continue to work in seed stitch to the first marker, sl the marker knitwise and work the pattern below between the markers, sl the second marker and work the last six sts after the marker in seed stitch again.

Row 1: K1, YO, K2tog, *K8, YO, SSK, repeat from * to

Row 2 and all even rows: Purl all sts.

Row 3: K2, YO, *K2tog, K5, SSK, YO, K1, YO, repeat from * to
Row 5: K3, *YO, K2tog, K3, SSK, YO, K3, repeat from * to
Row 7: K3, *K1, YO, K2tog, K1, SSK, YO, K4, repeat from * to
Row 9: K3, *K2, YO, Sl 1, K2tog, PSSO, YO, K5, repeat from * to
Row 11: K1, YO, K2tog, *K3, YO, K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, repeat from * to
Row 13: K2, YO, *K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, K3, YO, repeat from * to
Row 15: K3, *YO, K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, K3, repeat from * to
Row 17: K3, *K1, YO, K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, K2, repeat from * to
Row 19: K3, *K2, YO, K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, K1, repeat from * to
Row 21: K1, YO, K2tog, *K3, YO, K2tog, K3, YO, K2tog, repeat from * to
Row 23: K2, YO, *K2tog, K5, SSK, YO, K1, YO, repeat from * to
Row 25: K3, *YO, K2tog, K3, SSK, YO, K3, repeat from * to
Row 27: K3, *K1, YO, K2tog, K1, SSK, YO, K4, repeat from * to
Row 29: K3, *K2, YO, Sl1, K2tog, PSSO, YO, K5, repeat from * to
Row 31: SSK, YO, K1, *K2, SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, K1, repeat from * to
Row 33: K3, *K1, SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, K2, repeat from * to
Row 35: K3, *SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, K3, repeat from * to
Row 37: K2, SSK, *YO, K3, SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, repeat from * to
Row 39: K1, SSK, YO, *K3, SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, repeat from * to
Row 41: SSK, YO, K1, *K2, SSK, YO, K3, SSK, YO, K1, repeat from * to

Row 43: K2, YO * K2tog, K5, SSK, YO, K1, YO, repeat from * to
Row 44: Purl all stitches

Repeat from Rows 5-44 working the seed st border each side of the markers until piece measures 147cm from the beg, ending with a RS row.

End Border:

Next Row (WS): Work in seed st across the first six stitches, drop the marker. Purl across to the last six sts, increasing by 9 sts evenly across this section ... 124 sts

Next Row: *K1, P1, repeat from * to end.

Next Row: *P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

Repeat these two rows until the seed st border measures 5cm from the end of the lace work pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block to measurements.
