EASY CROCHET

Even the smallest of Halloween enthusiasts can join in on the fun with our babies pumpkin hat. This pattern is worked from the stalk down, features an easy, textured rib stitch and delicate picot edging. Our Imperial yarn has a wonderfully soft hand feel and is perfect for keeping your child's head cosy and warm. Shown here is our Newborn size pumpkin hat.

MEASUREMENTS

European Collection Imperial	100g balls	1	1	1	1	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

ITEM A: Newborn Sized Pumpkin Hat



DIFFICULTY ●●●

CROCHET HOOK & EQUIPMENT:

A 4.00mm crochet hook.
Green 8ply weight yarn for stem.
Stitch Markers.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

16 tr and 12 rows to 10cm over front post rib stitch, using 4.00mm hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

ch: chain
mr: magic ring, alternatively ch4 and slip stitch to create a circle.
sl st: slip stitch
dc: double crochet
tr: treble crochet
fp tr: front post treble crochet

BABIES PUMPKIN HAT

NOTE: This pattern is written for our Newborn size, all stitch counts and references for other sizes are written in brackets for easy reference. They are as follows, Newborn (0-3 mon - 3-6 mon - 6-12 mon - 12-18 mon)

STEM

Working in the Round:

Start with green yarn, hat is worked from the top down starting with the stem. Make a mr.

Round 1: ch1, 6dc into the mr, sl st to top of the ch1 to close round.

Round 2: ch1, dc in each st in the round, sl st to top of ch1 to close the round.

Repeat Round 2 until piece measures 10cm from the beginning or length for stalk desired.

Next Round: ch1, 2dc in each st in the round, sl st to top of ch1 to close the round ... 12dc

Next Round: ch1, *2dc into first st, dc in next st repeat from * to end of round, sl st to top of ch1 to close the round ... 18dc

PUMPKIN

For Crown of Head:

Next Round: Change to orange yarn, ch2 (does not count as a stitch), *2tr into each st in the round, sl st to top of ch2 to close the round ... 36tr

Next Round: ch2 (does not count as a stitch), *2tr into first st, fp tr into the next st, repeat from * to end of round, sl st to top of ch2 to close the round ... 54tr

3-6 month, 6-12 month & 6-12 month Sizes Only:

Next Round: ch2 (does not count as a stitch), *(tr, fp tr) into first st, tr into the next st, fp tr into the next st, repeat from * to end of round, sl st to top of ch2 to close the round ... 72tr

12-18 month Sizes Only:

Next Round: ch2 (does not count as a stitch), *(tr, fptr) into the first stitch, (tr, fptr) four times, repeat from * to end of round, sl st to top of ch2 to close the round ... 80tr

Main Section:**All Sizes:**

Next Round: ch2 (does not count as a stitch), *tr, fptr, repeat from * to end, sl st to the top of the ch2 to close the round.

Repeat the above round until piece measures 12 (13 - 14 - 15 - 16) cm from the base of the stem ... 54 (54 - 72 - 72 - 80) sts

Cuff:

Round 1: ch 1, dc into each st in the round, sl st to close the round.
Repeat Round 1 three times.

Picot Edge:**For All Sizes except 12-18 month:**

Next Round: Ch1, dc into each of the first 3 sts, *ch3, sl st into the 1st ch, dc3, repeat from * to end of round.

12-18 month size only:

Next Round: Ch1, dc into each of the first 4 sts, *ch3, sl st into the 1st ch, dc4, repeat from * to end of round.

FINISHING

Fasten off and weave in ends. Fold stalk over and st in place as per images.
